RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Grand Avenue Resurfacing Project from Plumas Street to Patrick Court is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Grand Avenue Resurfacing Project Plumas Street to Patrick Court in the Community of West Elsinore;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, March 3, 2021 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for approximately a mile of resurfacing on Grand Avenue from Plumas Street to Patrick Court in the Community of west Elsinore of Riverside County.

Grand Avenue currently ranges between a 2 and 4-lane road with roadway widths between 38 feet to 76 feet wide. Most of the roadway has curb and gutter on both sides, with one segment only having curb and gutter along the east side. Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Various pavement rehabilitation methods are being proposed throughout the project limits which will result in new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA) being placed throughout the project limits. Additional improvements include placement of AC dike, reconstruction of cross gutter, ADA compliant curb ramps, pavement safety edge and shoulder backing, placing of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs, relocation of pedestrian push button and other associated work. The existing signal at Patrick Court will also be upgraded to video detection.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Grand Avenue resurfacing project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use with the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

- Base Bid Schedule: Grand Avenue Resurfacing and associated work
- Alternate Bid Schedule: Lumen (Level 3 / CenturyLink) – Utility Facilities Adjustments

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

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STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

If Lumen approves the award of their respective alternate bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the reimbursement Agreement between the County and Lumen will be processed either prior to or concurrently with the award of contract.

Environmental Findings

The improvements to Grand Avenue are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt and rubberized hot mix asphalt for the approximate one-mile segment of Grand Avenue to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is anticipated to begin in late spring of 2021 and completed within one and a half months. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,708,495 and improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB1.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) is proposing to resurface approximately 5,057 feet of Grand Avenue from Plumas Street to Patrick Court. Grand Avenue is classified as a Major Highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Grand Avenue is a four lane road and currently ranges from 38' – 76' wide with the majority of the roadway having curb and gutter on both sides; there is a 476' section that is 38' wide with curb and gutter on the east side. The project will include the following:

- Milling down the existing AC pavement
- Paving with Hot Mix Asphalt and Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt
- Reconstruction of cross gutters and spandrels
- Reconstruction of AC dike
- Reconstruction of curb ramps to meet current ADA requirements
- Reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Utility adjustments
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
- Relocate pedestrian crossing buttons

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will not acquire right-of-way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to resurface approximately 5,057 feet of Grand Avenue from Plumas Street to Patrick Court. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because it does not create additional automobile lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

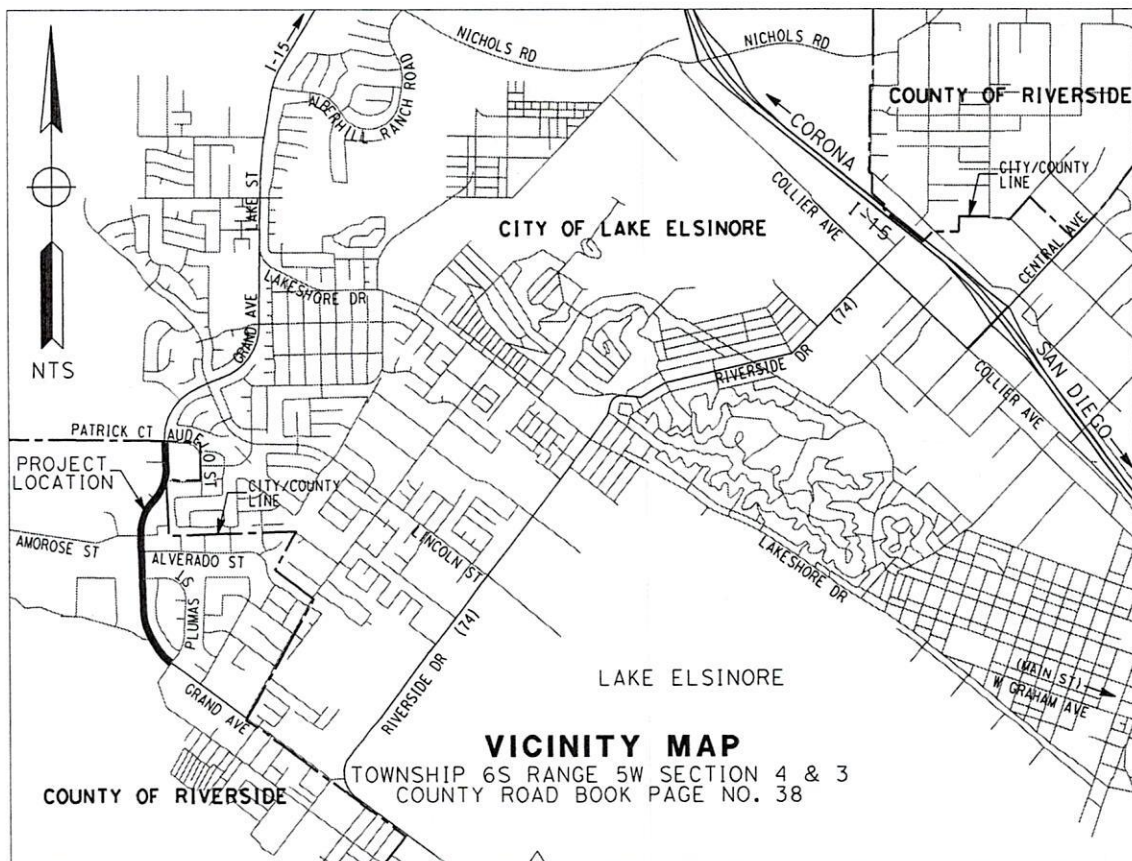
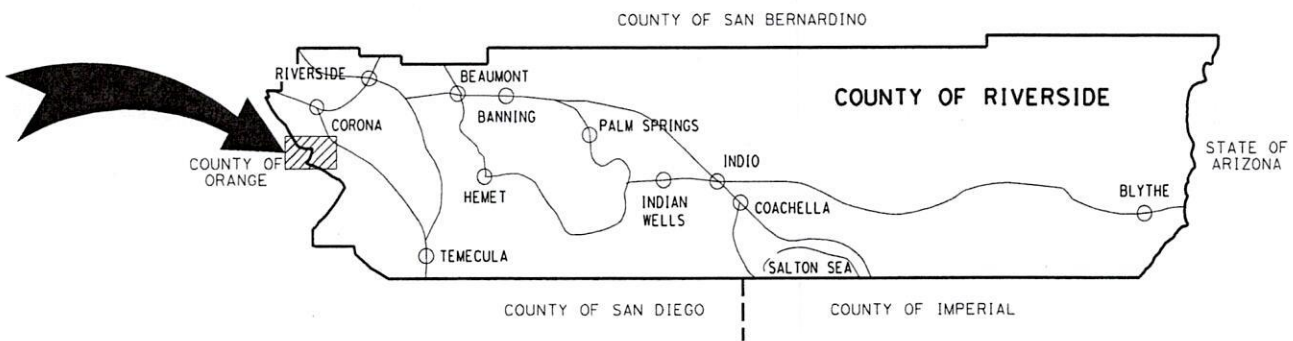

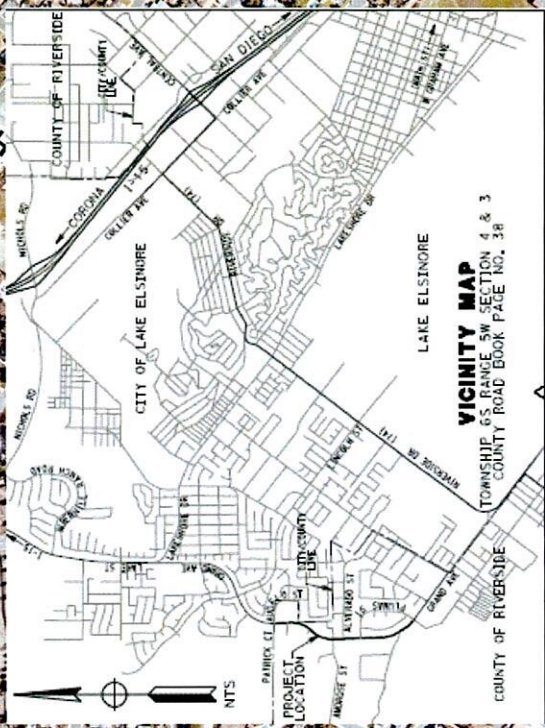

Project Location



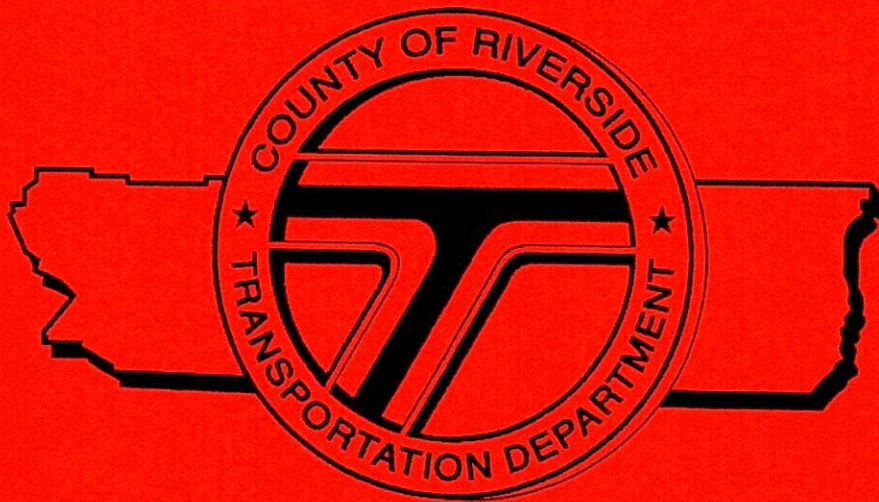
VICINITY MAP
