BACKGROUND:

Summary

In partnership with Lake Hemet Municipal Water District (LHMWD), the Project will construct six earthen recharge basins and approximately 3,000 lineal feet of underground waterline (see attached project description and location map). In conjunction with recharging stormwater runoff, the waterline will import and deliver surplus water to each recharge basin to promote infiltration and increase groundwater recharge in the Hemet-San Jacinto Valley groundwater basin areas. Any excess flows will return to the adjacent Bautista Creek Channel. LHMWD will assume the operation and maintenance of the Project upon construction completion. The Project is part of the District's Integrated Watershed Protection Program and will be eligible for 2015 Proposition 84 Integrated Regional Water Management grant funding.

On August 29, 2017, Minute Order 11.4 (MT#4851), and December 15, 2020, Minute Order 11.5 (MT#13909), the Board of Supervisors for the District approved the Cooperative Agreement and License Agreement, respectively, between the District and LHMWD for the Project. The Cooperative Agreement and License Agreement set forth the terms and conditions by which the District and LHMWD have agreed upon on the design, construction, maintenance and funding of the Project.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings

On December 13, 2016, Minute Order 11.3 (MT#2761), the Board of Supervisors for the District approved the Project, found that the Project will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment and found that the Project is in compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan. Pursuant to CEQA, a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was adopted and filed at the CEQA State Clearing House (SCH#2016081035). The Plans and Specifications and Contract Documents being approved today are implementing what was evaluated in the MND and are consistent with the Project as approved by the Board, therefore, nothing further is required under CEQA.

The contract documents have been approved as to form by County Counsel. A brief project description and location map is attached.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Impacts on Residents and Businesses are considered minimal. Residents and businesses could experience construction noise or dust from heavy equipment. The Project will improve groundwater recharge and water resiliency in the Hemet-San Jacinto Valley groundwater basin areas.

The action on this Form 11 merely approves the Plans and Specifications and Contract Documents identifying the proposed work, as well as authorizes the Clerk of the Board to advertise said contract documents. No expenses will be incurred as a result of this action.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The Engineer's estimate for this Project is \$1,437,866 and the action today, if approved, will authorize the District to pursue competitive bids through the California Public Works Contract Process. The District will then return to the Board of Supervisors to seek approval to award the contract to the lowest responsive bidder.


