3. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustment on the attached Schedule A.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

On January 13, 2021, the La Quinta Mayor signed the First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the City of La Quinta and the County of Riverside. This First Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the reduction of one (1) Deputy Sheriff. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated decrease of \$185,900 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2020-21. The Department is recommending these budget adjustments now as it could not anticipate them to include in its FY20/21 budget request.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of La Quinta approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.

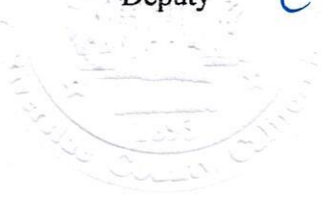
