BACKGROUND:

Summary

The department enters into an agreement annually with the California Department of Food and Agriculture to receive reimbursement for costs associated with inspecting plant nursery stock at all production locations within the county, in order to assure pest cleanliness.

This Agreement No. 1 to Cooperative Agreement No. 20-0412-000-SA increases the maximum contract amount by \$17,151.00 for a new contract amount of \$134,041.00 to cover additional expenses and enforcement activities.

This amendment was approved as to form by County Counsel.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Residents and businesses will be positively impacted in that invasive insect and disease pest species, as well as pests of common occurrence that are injurious to landscape and agricultural plants, as well as to the local environment, will be prevented from entering and becoming established within the county and the state. This will result in reduced pest control efforts/costs and an increased quality of life.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On September 15, 2020, Agenda Item 3.6, the Board of Supervisors ratified and approved Cooperative Agreement No. 20-0412-000-SA with the California Department of Food and Agricultural for the Nursery Inspection Program, effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, in the amount of \$116,890. Revenue from this source was previously included in the Agricultural Commissioner's FY 20/21 budget request. The increase in funds is required because additional funds were granted to raise the cost per acre from \$15.14 to \$17.35 acre.
