4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return all four (4) copies of the executed Woodcrest Dam Outlet Modification, Stage 90 Specifications and Contract Documents books to the District.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Project will improve the overall reliability, maintainability, safety, and functionality of Woodcrest Dam by replacing the existing intake structure and installing a new grated debris intake structure system, installing access stairs along the upstream embankment, and armoring both upstream and downstream embankment slopes with a combination of rock mulch and hydroseed to mitigate against erosion.

On December 15, 2020, Minute Order 11.1 (MT#14141), the Board of Supervisors (Board) for the District approved the Project and found the Project to be exempt from CEQA and in compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan. Pursuant to CEQA, a Notice of Exemption (NOE) was adopted and filed at the CEQA State Clearinghouse (SCH#2020120322). The Plans and Specifications and Contract Documents being approved today are implementing what was evaluated in the NOE and are consistent with the Project as approved by the Board, therefore, nothing further is required under CEQA.

The contract documents have been approved as to form by County Counsel. A brief project description and location map is attached.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

Impacts on residents and businesses is considered minimal. Residents and businesses could experience construction noise or dust from heavy equipment. The Project will improve flood protection and public safety in the project vicinity.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The action on this Form 11 merely approves the Plans and Specifications and Contract Documents identifying the proposed work, as well as authorizes the Clerk of the Board to advertise said contract documents. No expenses will be incurred as a result of this action.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

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The Engineer's estimate for this Project is \$1,133,387.60 and the action today, if approved, will authorize the District to pursue competitive bids through the California Public Works Contract Process. The District will then return to the Board of Supervisors to seek approval to award the Contract to the lowest responsive bidder.
