

## SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

BACKGROUND: The Riverside Transit Agency (RTA) is the main transit agency for western Riverside County. RTA provides both local and regional transit services, fixed-routes, Commuter Link routes and Dial-A-Ride services. In the cities of Corona, Beaumont and Banning, RTA coordinates regional services with municipal transit systems. In Riverside, RTA coordinates with the city's Riverside Special Services, which provides ADA complimentary services that connect to RTA's fixed-route services. RTA was established as a joint powers agency in 1975 and began operating bus service since 1977.
