2. Authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign the amendment on behalf of the County.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

This agreement is entered into with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for the County to enforce laws and regulations pertaining to industrial hemp cultivation, including registration requirements, in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding between the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the California Agricultural Commissioner's and Sealers Association.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Residents and businesses are positively impacted through uniform and consistent statewide enforcement of Industrial Hemp laws and regulations.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On August 25, 2020, the Board of Supervisors ratified and approved Cooperative Agreement No. 20-0338-000-SA with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for the Industrial Hemp Program, effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022, in the amount of \$124,050. Revenue from this source was previously included in the Agricultural Commissioner's FY 20/21 budget request. This amendment removes clause #25 "Property Damage Claims Process" in Exhibit B to be consistent with state regulations. All other terms and conditions of the agreement remain the same.

Removing:

25. Property Damage Claims Process

~~Should a property owner claim damages arising under, related to or involving this Agreement, the Recipient shall forward the property owner's written request for compensation to the CDFA Agreement Manager. The written request shall be fully supported by factual information. The Agency Secretary or designee will have thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of the written request to render a written decision. If a written decision is not rendered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of the request or the property owner disputes the CDFA's decision, the property owner may file a claim with the California Department of General Services.~~

The Scope of Work, term and total Agreement amount have not changed.

All other terms and conditions of this Agreement shall remain the same.
