#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary

By Minute Order dated December 15, 2020 (Agenda Item 3.46), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Re-Bid Ramona Expressway Resurfacing Project from Rider Street to Warren Road, approximately 9.2 miles, in the Communities of Nuevo, Lakeview, and Gilman Hot Springs in Supervisorial Districts 3 and 5.

Ramona Expressway is a two to four lane road; its width currently ranges from 40 to 120 feet. Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the Re-Bid Ramona Expressway Resurfacing Project will consist of four types of treatment.

Additional improvements include safety features such as placement of centerline channelizers and rumble strip to help alert drivers who may stray from the travel lanes and other associated work.

During the advertisement, period one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

Addendum No. 1 was issued to incorporate the Ramona Expressway Reconstruction Project. In general, this project consists of reconstructing the westbound number two lane of Ramona Expressway from 0.65 Miles East of Warren Road to 0.15 Miles West of Sanderson Avenue in the City of San Jacinto. Reconstruction of the lane includes removing the existing pavement and underlying material, followed by placing back HMA over Class 2 Aggregate Base.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Ramona Expressway resurfacing project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use with the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The City of San Jacinto has accepted the bid prices proposed by All American Asphalt for alternative bid schedules 1 and 3. A reimbursement agreement between the City of San Jacinto and County will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The contractor, All American Asphalt, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bond documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Regarding the project number for Ramona Expressway Reconstruction project, the original project number D1-0020 was replaced by project number D2-0018. All American Asphalt is aware that whenever and wherever in the Contract Documents the project number D1-0020 is used, it shall be understood to meant and refer to project number D2-0018.

## Environmental findings: Ramona Expressway Reconstruction Project

The project proposes to reconstruct Ramona Expressway from 0.65 Miles East of Warren Road to 0.15 Miles West of Sanderson Avenue in the City of San Jacinto. The project in its entirety is consistent with CEQA Section 15301(c) existing facilities exemption because it does not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

#### **Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate a deteriorated segment of Ramona Expressway, totaling approximately 9.2 miles, between Rider Street and Warren Road, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2021. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

#### SUPPLEMENTAL:

## **Additional Fiscal Information**

Construction is expected to be completed in FY 2020/21 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB1 funds and City of San Jacinto funds.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

#### Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Six bids were received on Wednesday January 6, 2021 ranging from \$7,916,616 to \$9,684,696. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt in the amount of \$7,916,616 which is \$668,801 (7.8%) below the Engineer's Estimate. The contract amount (\$7,903,891) varies from bid amount (\$7,916,616) because Alternative Bid Schedule 2 in the amount of \$12,725 is not selected for award.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to All American Asphalt in the amount of \$7,903,891.

#### Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and <u>All American Asphalt</u>, hereafter called "Contractor".

#### WITNESSETH

#### Recitals:

- 1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, Re-Bid Ramona Expressway Resurfacing, Rider Street to Warren Road; Communities of Nuevo, Lakeview, and Gilman Hot Springs; Project No. C8-0055, C1-0577; and Ramona Expressway Reconstruction, 0.65 Miles East of Warren Road to 0.15 Miles West of Sanderson Avenue, City of San Jacinto, Project No. D2-0018, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
- 2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

#### Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

#### 1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders. (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of 2018 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (One), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

#### 2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents

### 3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within <u>fifteen (15)</u> calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

#### 4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.
