Hello to the Riverside Board of Supervisors -

My name is Jennifer Lensing. I was the first speaker today. Unfortunately I had the first speaker jitters while speaking today, but this was the main point I wanted to bring to your attention.

The CDC and CDPH made a change to the 6ft rule by making it 3ft which is strongly recommended, but not required. Cal Osha has the same distance listed as the CDC. This will double the capacity of classrooms and per the ADA this 3ft rule was put into place well before the pandemic for wheelchair accommodations. What this means is that every school in the state of California can be open full time. The reason why I am coming to you is because this needs to come from the county level. Everytime we go to our School Board of Supervisors they refer back to you. I think Karen Speigal mentioned there is a gray area. I would like further clarification on that comment? I could have heard that wrong so if there is a gray area could you please let me know what that means? As per SB98 it states all districts to provide distance learning, but students are to be offered in person instruction to the greatest extent possible. In that SB98 it does say the local Public Health Officer can keep our schools closed. Kaiser was not an elected official by the people and given our 2 weeks to stop the spread turning into a year I have little faith that he will ever represent us. You elected Kaiser in his position; we did not! We did however elect you into your position and it is your duty and under oath to protect the Constitution. In the Constitution it states that our kids have the right to attend school, by not opening you are violating equal protection laws, as there are many schools open. According to the restraining order against Newsom any enforcement to state rules doesn't need to be enforced. So therefore all schools must open now! Next week is the bigger "Covid" meeting so again I just want to get ahead of the next "narrative" which is vaccinations. Teachers have already been put in front of the line to be vaccinated, which means they took away from people in need, so therefore it is time to get back to the classroom NOW! As for the children these are vaccinations under emergency use so we do not know much about them. In that case I am just letting you know now we the people do not consent to forced vaccinations. As a concerned parent of children, who are really not affected by this virus at all, I will not be forced to give my child this vaccination in order to attend school. Given the direction everything has gone I am getting ahead of that. Vaccinations should be for those who want them and need them, but not forced! Especially our youth for a virus that does not harm them and cannot be eradicated as it is a mutating virus.
