#### BACKGROUND:

#### **Summary**

Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution No. 2021-002 adopted January 26, 2021, the Board of Supervisors gave notice of a public hearing for March 23, 2021, to receive testimony regarding the Annexation of Zone 213 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Zone 213 will fund ensuring the maintenance and servicing of dormant parkway landscaping within public rights-of-way located east of Contreras Road and west of Hill Street in the Anza area and includes one commercial parcel totalling 1.31 acres.

The annexation of territory to an existing assessment district formed under the Landscaping and Lighting Act is a change of organization that requires a public hearing as part of the annexation process per Streets & Highways Code §§ 22605(a), 22607, 22588; Gov't. Code § 53753(d).

On January 27, 2021 a notice of the public hearing and information sheet, a mail-in assessment ballot, an impartial analysis, and a copy of Resolution No. 2021-002 was mailed to all property owners within Zone 213, proposed for annexation to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Pursuant to the notice, all assessment ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2021-002 in an appropriate newspaper at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of Resolution No. 2021-002 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two (2) other public locations within the County.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The new assessment is for the purpose of ensuring the maintenance and servicing of dormant parkway landscaping within public right-of-way.

Only the commercial property owners within the proposed boundaries of Zone 213, which are represented by Plot Plan No. 26320, as described in the attached Exhibit "A" (a two-page exhibit containing a description and diagram) are impacted by the cost of this annexation. The property

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owners within the proposed boundaries of Zone 213 have petitioned the County of Riverside to annex their property to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and understand that this annexation will result in an assessment on their property to fund the maintenance and servicing of the aforementioned improvements (dormant parkway landscaping).

#### **SUPPLEMENTAL:**

#### **Additional Fiscal Information**

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2021-22 for Zone 213 is \$1,972. This will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2021-22 within Zone 213 of \$1,505 per acre. The annual assessment may be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U), if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2021.
