


BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The James O. Jessie Desert Highland Unity Center's mission is to create a healthier society; contribute to civic pride in a livable community; and decrease youth delinquency by providing safe and inviting parks, and inclusive programming. The Youth Encouragement program has been an avenue of positivity for youth to strive for greatness. CID funds will be utilized to support this program for their program supplies, marketing, motivational speakers, educational and recreational excursions, and meals for the participants.
2. The high school baseball program at Coachella Valley High School has been in existence since the school first opened. The baseball team impacts the development and attitude of all the participants in a positive manner with direction and accountability. Recently, the baseball equipment container was broken into and the majority of the team's equipment was stolen. CID funds will be used to help replace some of the lost equipment.
3. Culturas Music Arts hosted their 8th Annual Women Rising event on March 20th. The free event was a celebration to recognize women's history month. Music, arts and vendors participated in this event. CID funds will be utilized to help cover the expenses for art installations, literature and awards.
4. KERU's mission is to educate farmworkers and all listeners who reside in the surrounded areas of Blythe. The radio station helps promote free resources, and has educated the community regarding COVID-19, vaccine, mental health, education and more. CID funds will help cover the costs of their facility.
