RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Washington Street and Saddleback Road Pavement Widening and Traffic Signal Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of Washington Street and Saddleback Road Pavement Widening and Traffic Signal Project, Woodcrest Community;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing improvements by construction of Washington Street and Saddleback Road Pavement Widening and Traffic Signal Project in the Woodcrest Community of Riverside County.

At this T-intersection, Washington Street is two lane facility that travels in the north-south directions and Saddleback Road is also two lane local road that travels in the east-west directions.

Proposed improvements include installing new traffic signal poles and mast-arms, safety lights, traffic signal cabinets, battery backup system, underground conduits and wiring, pull boxes, foundations, radar/video detection system, wireless radio communication system, new striping, new traffic signs, pavement widening at intersection, concrete retaining wall, erosion control, ADA compliant curb returns, curb and gutter, replacing existing traffic striping and traffic signs, and other associated work as directed by the Engineer.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c), Existing Facilities Exemption because it does not create additional automobile lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements.

The work is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2021. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$813,095 and will be funded with Western County DIF Signal Mitigation Funds. The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Washington Street and Saddleback Road in the Woodcrest area of Riverside County. Washington Street is a two-lane arterial street that travels in the north-south direction, with an existing width of approximately 34 feet of pavement, 12 feet of through lane and 5 feet of paved shoulder, and asphalt dike on both sides. Saddleback Road is a two-lane local road that travels in the east-west direction, with an existing width of approximately 36 feet of pavement and 18 feet of through lane, and curb and gutter on both sides. The proposed project will include the following:

- Installation of traffic signal poles, safety lighting, mast arms, cabinets, conduits, pull-boxes, and other traffic signal equipment
- Minor widening of Washington Street by saw-cutting and removing existing pavement
- Construction of new pavement section
- Excavation/grading of slope and subgrade
- Construction of a retaining wall
- Construction of an overside drain pipe
- Reconstruction of overside drains and driveways
- Utility relocation
- Vegetation removal

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: The proposed project will not acquire right-of-way. Temporary construction easements may be required.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance and therefore is a covered activity.

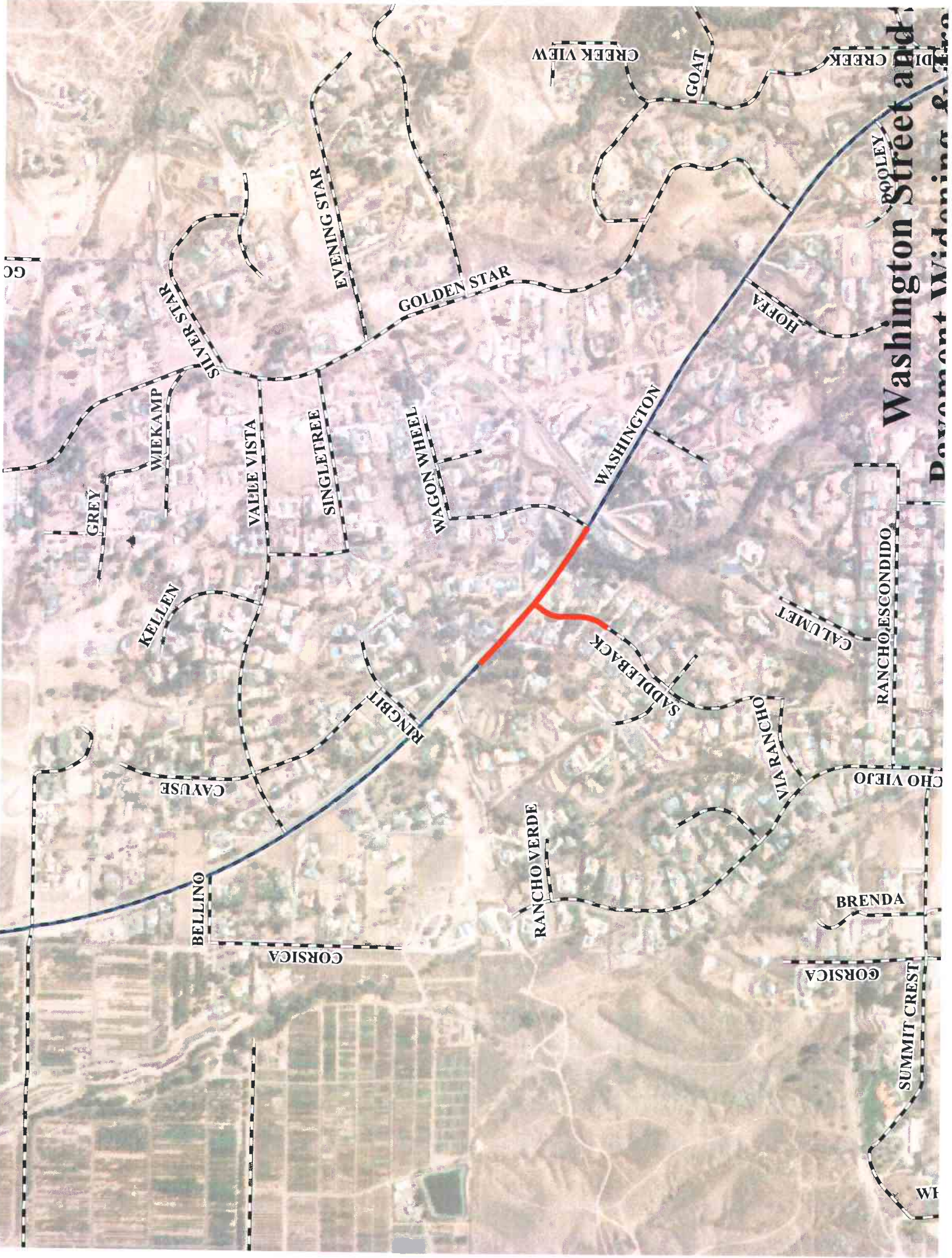

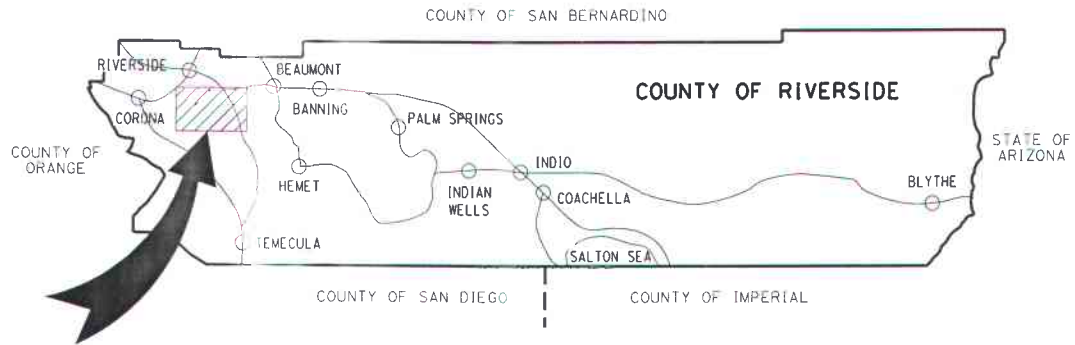
