District 5. [\$958,784 Total Cost - Local Funds 100%] (Clerk to Advertise)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Central Avenue and Ramona Avenue Resurfacing Projects are categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the Central Avenue Resurfacing Project and Ramona Avenue Resurfacing Project in the Community of Nuevo;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 5, 2021 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemptions with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the resurfacing of an approximate 0.75 mile segment of Central Avenue from Menifee Road to Rosary Avenue, and an approximate 0.14 mile segment of Ramona Avenue from Nuevo Road to Stalder Avenue in the Community of Nuevo, Riverside County.

The two projects are combined to bid as one project in order to gain cost efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures and to seek more favorable bids associated with larger bid quantities.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed resurfacing of Central Avenue and Ramona Avenue consists of removing the existing pavement to the depths specified on the plans and replacing with new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA).

Additional improvements include the installation of asphalt concrete (AC) over-side drains, AC driveways, AC dikes, reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter, curb ramps, cross-gutters, and spandrels, installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, and the installation of traffic signs and any other associated work as may be required.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Central Avenue and Ramona Avenue resurfacing projects are Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB-1 these needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

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Base Bid 1: Ramona Avenue Resurfacing Project

Base Bid 2: Central Avenue Resurfacing Project

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Project No. C9-0025, Central Avenue Resurfacing Project
C9-0036, Ramona Avenue Resurfacing Project

Environmental Findings

The proposed project will resurface approximate 0.75 miles of Central Avenue from Menifee Road to Rosary Avenue and approximate 0.14 mile segment of Ramona Avenue from Nuevo Road to Stalder Avenue. These improvements are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c), Existing Facilities Exemption, because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of Central Avenue and Ramona Avenue to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in Summer of this year. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$958,784 and improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 780 feet of Ramona Avenue between Nuevo Road and Stalder Avenue. Ramona Avenue is a two lane facility with a road width of 23-25 feet that travels in the North-South direction. The project will include the following:

- Pavement removal
- Paving with Hot Mix Asphalt
- Replace AC dike
- Driveway replacements and construction of new driveways
- Utility adjustments
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will not acquire right-of-way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to resurface approximately 780 feet of Ramona Avenue from Nuevo Road to Stalder Avenue. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because it does not create additional automobile lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Central Avenue is classified as a Local Collector Street in the County of Riverside General Plan. Central Avenue is a two lane road and currently ranges from 23-42 feet wide. The project will include the following:

- Paving with Hot Mix Asphalt
- Driveway replacements and construction of new driveways
- Utility adjustments
- Drainage improvements, including reconstruction of existing irregular berm; construction of new dikes, over side drains, and down drains
- Remove and replace cross gutter
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
