



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside County Facilities Management - \$10,000** to be utilized to assist with construction costs to create a small field office for Code Enforcement at the Lakeland Village Community Center within an existing building. The construction will create a working space for code staff members to work when in the community, as well as a shared conference room for use by other county agencies and community meetings.
