BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated January 26, 2021 (Agenda Item 3.29), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project, Phase 2 from 18th Avenue to Dillon Road, in the Community of North Palm Springs of unincorporated County of Riverside.

The initial project was divided into two phases due to the right of way required to construct the improvements and relocate the conflicting Southern California Edison poles north of 18th Avenue. Phase 1 construction between 20th Avenue and 18th Avenue in the Cities of Palm Springs and Desert Hot Springs within District 4 has been completed.

The project limit of Phase 2 is from 18th Avenue to Dillon Road, within the Community of North Palm Springs of Riverside County within the 5th Supervisorial District.

This Phase 2 Project proposes to widen approximately 3,300 feet of roadway and reconstruct approximately 700 feet north of Dillon Road, and approximately 1000 feet to the east and west of North Indian Canyon Drive along Dillan Road. Construction will include the installation of a new traffic signal and lighting at the intersection of North Indian Canyon Drive and Dillon Road. North Indian Canyon Drive is classified as an Arterial Highway and currently is a two lane road with curb, gutter and sidewalk along various segments of the roadway. The proposed improvements will add one lane of travel in each direction by widening 8 to 14 feet of pavement and the existing pavement will be overlaid with new Hot Mix Asphalt.

Additional improvements include construction of concrete curb and gutter, placement of shoulder backing, utility adjustments and roadway signing, striping and thermoplastic pavement markings, replacement of existing signs and other associated work. All required right-of-way has been acquired to construct the Phase 2 improvements.

Mission Springs Water District (MSWD) is currently constructing a sewer line within the project limits and requested to enter into a Cooperative Agreement for utility adjustments and required new pavement over their proposed sewer main. This work was added by Addendum No. 1 as Base Bid Schedule 2 to the project and MSWD concurred with the proposed bid prices.

The Contract includes following schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule 1: North Indian Canyon Widening, Traffic Signal and associated work

Base Bid Schedule 2: MSWD funded work

During the advertisement period, three addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The Addenda are included and attached herewith as Addendum No.1, 2 and 3.

The Bid received from All American Asphalt has an immaterial bid irregularity that is a transposition of a letter in a subcontractor's name. Bid Shows EC Traffic Specialist which should have been BC Traffic Specialist. Transportation Department requesting the Board of Supervisors to waive the immaterial irregularity.

The contractor, All American Asphalt is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid. They have executed the Contract and have provided bonds and insurance documents that meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed widening of North Indian Canyon Drive will greatly improve traffic conditions, reduce delay, and accommodate future growth in the region.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer 2021. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Contract is recommended to be awarded to All American Asphalt for the total amount of \$1,998,488. The construction contract is funded by Coachella Valley Association of Governments - Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fee funds and Mission Springs Water District. There are no General Funds used in this project.

On February 27, 2018 (Item 3.59), the Board approved a Cooperative Funding Agreement and Amendment Number One with the Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG) that

approved a total project cost of \$4 million for North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project. Amendment Number Two is being approved concurrently as MT Item 14889 which increases the estimated project cost to \$4,788,000, \$4,488,000 of which will be allocated towards the County's North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project. The remaining \$300,000 were allocated the City of Palm Springs to resurface a portion of the project limits between 18th and 19th Avenue. The County will be responsible for paying their fair share (25%) of the \$4,488,000 project costs. The reimbursement will be paid through a separate project number, C70029 and is estimated as \$795,475.

The proposed budgets as shown on Attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Nine bids were received on Wednesday February 24, 2021, ranging from \$1,998,488 to \$2,589,898. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt in the amount of \$1,998,488 which is \$38,523 (1.97%) above the Engineer's Estimate; however, it is within the bid target limit of 5% above the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible contractor, All American Asphalt.






Item 3: SOUND WALL (MASONRY BLOCK)

Refer to section 58 Sound Walls on page 46 of the Special Provisions. The Special Provision Section "Sound Wall (Masonry Block)" is deleted and replaced with the following:

Masonry Block Wall

Masonry block walls shall be constructed in accordance with the Section 58-2 "Masonry Block" of the Standard Specification, the plans, Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

- Masonry Block Wall with Masonry Pilasters per County of Riverside Building and Safety Standards.

The cementitious material content of concrete must be at least 505 pounds per cubic yard or as specified on standard drawings.

The contractor shall remove and/or relocate following existing items as applicable and as directed.

- Remove wrought iron and reinstall on new wall
- Relocate electric motor for gate
- Relocate rolling gate and security post to same depth
- Relocate gate access controller to new wall
- Remove existing overhead sign and provide electrical stub out for future use

Compensation for the above listed items shall be included in the bid price for Masonry Block Wall

Where it is necessary and/or required by property owner, temporary fence/gate shall be placed for the safety of the owner and their property or the protection of owner's pets. The cost for this temporary fencing shall be considered as included in the contract unit prices paid per linear feet for Masonry Block wall.

Electrical fixtures will salvaged and returned to the property owner. Compensation for removing, salvaging and delivery shall be considered as included in the contract price paid per linear foot for Masonry Block Wall.

The Contractor shall furnish and install all electrical wiring and conduit required within the new wall to provide for connection of motors and access controller. During excavation existing utilities shall be protected in-place. Prior to performing any excavation, the contractor shall determine if any of the existing utilities, as shown by DigAlert markings, exist within 3 feet of the closest point of the planned excavation. If any existing underground utilities are within 3 feet of the excavation area, the Contractor shall carefully pothole and expose the

utility to determine its exact location. If the existing utility is found to be in conflict with the planned excavation, the matter shall be brought to the attention of the Engineer.

The Contractor will not be directly reimbursed for determining the exact location of the utility lines or services laterals but shall include any compensation for this work in the contract price paid per linear foot for the Masonry Block Wall.

Payment:

The contract unit price paid per linear foot for Masonry Block Wall will not be adjusted if the constructed height of said minor structure, including revisions by Engineer, is within ± 0.5 foot of the vertical dimension shown on the plans.

- 3.3. Drill shall be high speed, high torque capable of supplying enough power to thoroughly mix MMA AREA MARKING additives when paired with a paint mixing paddle.

4. APPLICATION:

- 4.1. Pre-conditions. Aged surfaces containing reflective cracking should be repaired, or it should be expected that reflective cracking may re-appear.

- 4.2. Surface preparation. Clean the intended application area thoroughly. All loose particles, dirt, sand dust, etc. must be removed. Broom and use a power blower or compressed air. The surface must be clean, dry and free of all dust, oil, debris and any other material that might interfere with the bond between MMA AREA MARKINGS and the surface to be treated.

- 4.2.1. Concrete: All curing compounds shall be completely removed from concrete surfaces prior to installation by shot blasting or grinding. Existing concrete surfaces shall be wire brushed, but may require shot blasting or grinding dependent on condition.

- 4.2.2. Chemical contaminants: Clean areas containing chemical contaminants such as vehicle fluids, using a degreasing solution, and ensure removal of contaminants and degreasing solution well in advance of the application.

- 4.2.3. Obstacles: Pavement markings that are to be left in place, utilities, drainage structures, curbs and any other structure within or adjacent to the treatment location shall be masked to protect from application. Existing pavement markings conflicting with the surface treatment should be removed by grinding or water blasting. Extra care should be taken to thoroughly remove the dust and debris caused from grinding.

- 4.3. Mixing. Catalyst quantity shall be based on ambient and pavement temperature and must be mixed very thoroughly at specified rates and into materials listed in the materials mixing guide. Material shall mix to approximately 2.79 gallons (10.55 liters) and weigh approximately 52 lbs (23.6 kg).

- 4.4. Installation. MMA AREA MARKINGS shall immediately be poured onto the pavement and distributed at 45-50 sq. ft. per pail using a squeegee. Trowels can be used where a squeegee is not effective. Use roller to back roll MMA AREA MARKINGS to remove

working lines and create a consistent, anti-slip texture. Remove masking as material gels, but before it cures.

- 4.5. Opening to traffic. MMA AREA MARKING's must be 100% cured, which will be a hardened solid state, before traffic is permitted. Curing typically takes 30-60 minutes and is based on temperature and amount of catalyst added.


