BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated February 2, 2021 (Agenda Item 3.30), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Lincoln Street Pavement Restoration and Sidewalk Project (Project) consists of the reconstruction of pavement along Lincoln Street from 5th Street to 62nd Avenue and the addition of sidewalk along the east side of Lincoln Street from 5th Street to 7th Street. The sidewalk will increase the network of sidewalks that residents use to access services in downtown Mecca.

Roadway resurfacing was needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The work includes removal of the existing pavement, pulverizing the existing pavement in place, compacting the subgrade followed by a base pavement course of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and an overlay of Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA). The additional improvements on the east side of Lincoln Street between 5th Street and 7th Street, include the construction of concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter, curb ramps, driveways, the removal or replacement of fences and gates, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Lincoln Street is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB-1 this needed road repair project would have not been possible until funding became available.

The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest bid was submitted by LC Paving; however, the Transportation Department considers their bid to be non-responsive because the Bid Bond submitted was prepared on a different form other than the one provided in the Bid Book. The Bid Bond did not meet the Bid submittal requirements; therefore, the bid received from LC Paving is considered a non-responsive bid proposal. Transportation Department sent a letter dated March 8, 2021, to notify LC Paving regarding the Department's action to find their bid to be non-responsive, and selection of second low bidder to award this contract. 1. The next lowest responsive bid was submitted by second low bidder, Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$2,558,552.

The contractor, Granite Construction Company is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid. They have executed the Contract and have provided bonds and insurance documents that meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The pavement improvements will benefit residents and businesses by improving the road driving surface, reducing wear and tear on vehicles, and improving vehicular safety. The sidewalk improvements will improve the network of walkway connectivity throughout downtown Mecca, a community that is highly walking-oriented.

The work is anticipated to begin in May 2021 and will be completed approximately in three months. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Contract is recommended to be awarded to Granite Construction Company for the total amount of \$2,558,552. The construction contract is funded with Gas Tax/SB-1. There are no General Funds used in this project.

The proposed budgets as shown on Attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Eight bids were received on Wednesday February 24, 2021, ranging from \$2,423,100 to \$3,268,400. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$2,558,552 which is \$228,723 (-8.21%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible contractor, Granite Construction Company.

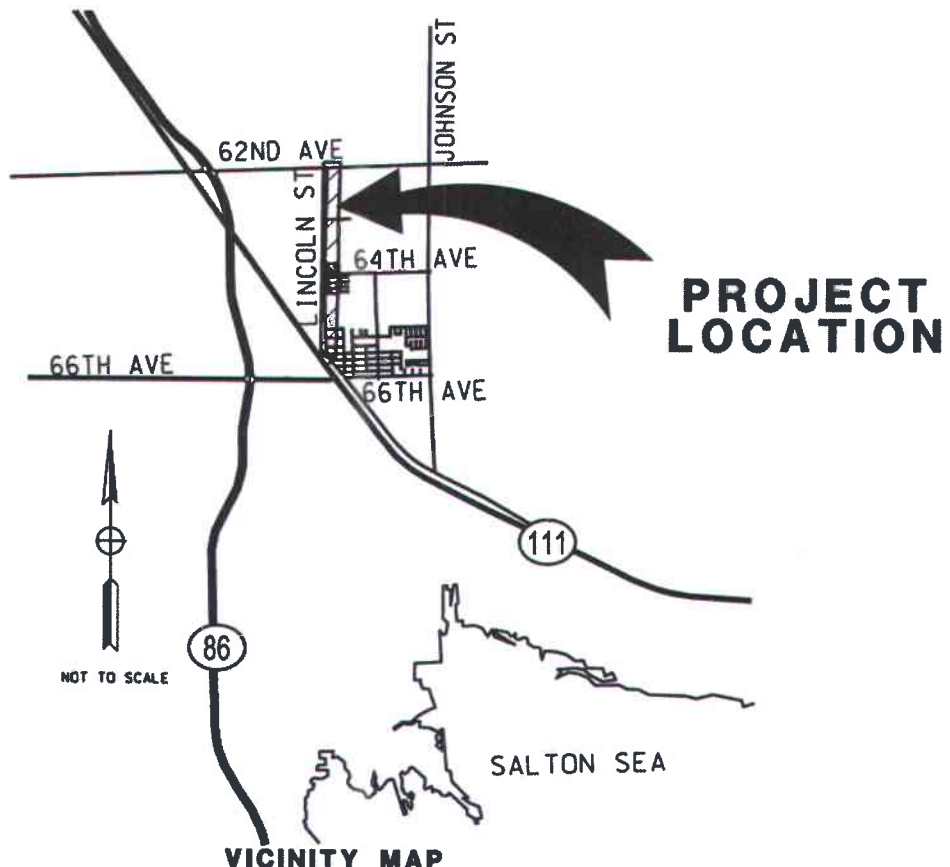
