#### BACKGROUND:

#### Summary

Waste Collection Franchise Agreements covering most unincorporated portions of Riverside County were phased in between 1997 and 1998. Within each of the existing eleven Franchise Agreements is a provision for an annual adjustment of the rates effective each July 1st. The franchise areas are spread throughout the entire county unincorporated area and are present within each Supervisor's District.

This adjustment allows a pass through for any changes to landfill costs including the Alternative Daily Cover surcharge or transfer station fees, plus an increase based on Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the balance of the rate. Costs are adjusted by the CPI for the Riverside/San Bernardino/Ontario, California, as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. The proposed rates were adjusted as delineated in the franchise agreement using a CPI of 2.2% for the change from January 2020 to January 2021. DVD is subject to other increases that are dictated by their waste delivery agreements with Burrtec who operates the transfer stations at Edom Hill and Coachella and is reflected in the 2.2% increase in disposal costs noted on their rate sheets.

In addition to the changes for CPI the haulers are adding bundled rates for three bin service for commercial accounts in compliance with State mandates.

The detailed rate calculation worksheets factoring in the CPI increase have been reviewed for accuracy and the updated rate sheets are maintained by the Department of Environmental Health.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The current typical residential accounts pay \$26.92 a month. The approval of the proposed CPI increase and recycling processing fee increase would result in a rate of \$27.49 per month. Commercial customers rates vary based on the size of bins and frequency of services provided. The rates attached also include an increase to disposal costs which are

addressed in a separate request from the Department of Waste Resources to adjust the landfill tipping fees for solid waste disposal by 2.25%.

The approval of this change will result in no cost to the County; implementation expenses are borne by the franchisee.
