

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On August 27, 2020, the Palm Desert City Council approved the First Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement for a modification of the level of service for FY20/21. This First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the City of Palm Desert modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the deletion of one (1) Sheriff's Sergeant and ten (10) Deputy Sheriff positions and the addition of three (3) Community Service Officer Positions. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated decrease of \$3,349,000 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2020-21. The Department has included the cost estimate in its budget; therefore, no budget adjustment is necessary.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of Palm Desert approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.
