

BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

The County of Riverside, on behalf of its Emergency Management Department, Emergency Medical Services Agency, entered into the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with American Medical Response Ambulance Service, Inc. (AMR) for Special Emergency Medical Services Programs as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The MOU was for the period of January 28, 2020, through December 31, 2020, and was ratified and approved by the Board of Supervisors on September 29, 2020. The MOU provides for special emergency medical services programs to be provided to the County which includes non-transport special EMS programs approved by the Riverside County EMS Agency (REMSA). Examples of functions considered special emergency medical services programs includes: COVID-19 testing sites, skilled nursing operational support, quick response strike teams to support skilled nursing facilities, and other COVID-19 response support as necessary during the pandemic. Since January 2021, AMR is providing support to vaccine sites.

Amendment No. 1 to the MOU with AMR extends the contract period for an additional six months through June 30, 2021, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

AMR is uniquely positioned to aid in the provision of non-transport EMS programs that will benefit County of Riverside residents by supporting congregate living facilities, hospitals, clinics, and other public health agencies within the County.

Additional Fiscal Information

The programs and personnel provided by AMR from March 1, 2020, to December 30, 2020, pursuant to the MOU were fully funded by the County's allocation of the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CARES Act Funding). Services after December 30, 2020, will be paid by the County and submitted to FEMA as part of the County's reimbursement claim.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The County and American Medical Response Ambulance Service Inc. entered into the Agreement, Contract No. 15-097, for emergency ambulance service within Riverside County for the period of July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2020, approved by the Board of Supervisors on

January 13, 2015. On December 11, 2018, the third one-year amendment (Amendment No. 3) was approved by the Board of Supervisors to extend the contract term through June 30, 2023. On September 29, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved the Memorandum of Understanding to Contract 15-097, which allowed for special emergency medical services programs to be provided to the County as a response to the COVID-19 pandemic through December 31, 2020.

The requested service was initiated as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. As per the Director of Emergency Services Emergency Procurement Order dated March 26, 2020, the competitive bidding process was suspended for necessary goods and services immediately needed in the County of Riverside's operations for the preservation of life and property during the existence of a Local Emergency in the County of Riverside regarding COVID-19.

This First Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") is entered into by and between the County of Riverside ("COUNTY") and American Medical Response Ambulance Service, Inc. ("AMR").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, COUNTY and AMR entered into the MOU (also identified as MOU-AMR-15-097) for Special Emergency Medical Services Programs to be provided as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic for the COUNTY on behalf of its Emergency Management Department; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY now desires to extend the Agreement through June 30, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct.

2. The first sentence of Section 2 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"The term of this MOU shall be from January 28, 2020 (the "Effective Date") through June 30, 2021 or the duration of the existence of the Local Emergency throughout the County of Riverside, terminating on the date that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside terminates its proclamation of said Local Emergency."

3. This First Amendment shall be effective January 1, 2021.
