

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Children and Families Commission ("First 5 Commission") is a department agency of the County and was created by Riverside County Ordinance No. 784. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 130140.1, the First 5 Commission is responsible to provide a comprehensive, collaborative, and integrated system to promote and support early childhood development from prenatal to five (5) years of age. The First 5 Commission receives funding from the California Children and Families Commission and places those funds into the Riverside County Children and Families Trust Fund for the exclusive use of the First 5 Commission.

Ordinance No. 784 requires submission of the Commission's by-laws and any subsequent amendments to the Board of Supervisors for review and comment.

The amendments incorporate changes made to Riverside County Ordinance No. 784, as recently amended in Ordinance No. 784.11, and to provide additional clarity around responsibilities of Commission officers and meeting governance. The amended bylaws were approved by the Commission at the January 21, 2021 Commission meeting.
