

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Department of Environmental Health (DEH) administers the Waste Hauler Franchise Agreements with Burrtec, CR&R, Desert Valley Disposal, and Waste Management of the Inland Empire (Haulers). Payment disbursements of delinquent trash assessments are currently collected, reconciled, and distributed to the Haulers by DEH. However, payment of past due accounts by parcel owners have become cumbersome to reconcile for DEH staff.

DEH has evaluated the merits of enrolling Hauler Districts 68-0003, 68-0007, 68-0008, 68-0009, 68-0010, like the currently enrolled Franchise Area 8 in the Mountain Area. Enrolling the Hauler Districts into the Auditor-Controller's Teeter Program would expedite disbursements and prevent further delays of funds to the Haulers, therefore reconciled on a fiscal year basis and require less DEH staff time to process.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

No financial impact to parcel owners will result from this action. Positive impacts to the Haulers would result from expedited payments through the Teeter program.

17 Teeter Program for the following Waste Hauler Franchise Districts: 68-0003, 68-0007, 68-0008, 68-0009, 68-
18 0010.

20 of California, in regular session assembled on May 25, 2021, finds that the Department of Environmental Health
