- 4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days of Board approval.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The slurry seal treatment is provided as a preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. The slurry seal treatment seals small cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface and helps preserve the underlying pavement structure. This project includes various roads located within the communities of North Palm Springs, Thousand Palms, Bermuda Dunes, Thermal, Desert Center, Palo Verde Valley, and the unincorporated areas near City of Yucaipa and Western Coachella Valley. The specific roads are listed in "Attachment 1".

The slurry seal project proposes slurry seal, micro-surfacing, chip seal, and double chip seal treatments based on the existing pavement conditions. The slurry seal treatment consists of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregates, water and other additives placed over the existing asphalt pavement surface. This work includes road cleaning, crack repairs, application of seal coat treatment, installation of new thermoplastic crosswalks, replacement of striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers. All roads will be swept several times at specified intervals after the slurry has been applied.

The micro-surfacing treatment is similar to the slurry seal except it uses polymer modified and fast setting asphalt emulsion allowing thicker layers to be placed. The thick layer application allows to fill in ruts commonly found on roadways with light to moderate truck traffic.

The chip seal treatment consists of an application of asphalt emulsion and then followed by a layer of chip or small crushed rock (screenings). The treatment provides a skid resistant wearing surface and seals minor cracks and it is generally used for low volume rural roads.

The double chip seal treatment is similar to the chip seal in terms of application except the treatment is applied twice. It provides the same benefits as the chip seal and it is mainly used on fair to moderately distressed low volume rural roads.

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This project also proposes to reconstruct or upgrade thirty (30) existing concrete curb ramps at various locations within 4th District as part of the Transportation Department goal to provide safe and usable pedestrian facilities for all pedestrians and to comply with the Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. As part of the ADA requirement, curb ramps must be upgraded when adjoining roads are altered through resurfacing or placement of a thick layer of seal coat. The specific curb ramps locations are listed in "Attachment 2."

The proposed curb ramp accesibility work will consist of modifying or removing existing concrete curb ramps and placing back ADA compliant concrete curb ramps. Certain curb ramps will be upgraded by installing yellow detectable warning devices (series of small bumps or truncated domes) and making repairs to street landing slopes to meet ADA compliance. Detectable warning devices are used to alert pedestrians who are blind or visually impaired that there is vehicle traffic nearby.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Slurry Seal and associated work
Alternative Bid Schedule 1: Curb Ramp and associated work

Alternative Bid Schedule 2: Slurry Seal and associated work, City of Coachella Portion
Alternative Bid Schedule 3: Slurry Seal and associated work, City of Palms Springs Portion

Alternative Bid Schedule 4: Slurry Seal and associated work, City of Yucaipa Portion

If the low bid is approved and concurred to by the Cities of Coachella, Palm Springs, and Yucaipa for their respective alternative bid schedule of work, then a reimbursement agreement between each City and the County will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Project Numbers: D2-0009 and D2-0010 (Slurry Seal)

D2-0014 (Curb Ramp)

Environmental Findings

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the slurry seal treatment and the reconstruction or modification of curb ramps does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadways and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The Slurry Seal treatment will extend the life of the pavement thereby reducing the need for more extensive types of resurfacing that can be up to ten times more costly.

The reconstruction of curb ramps is expected to improve the access and safety of disabled persons using the pedestrian facilities along the roadways. In addition, bringing the curb ramps up to current accessibility standards contributes toward fulfilling the County Transportation Department's goals as stated in its ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan as required by Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$4,026,978 and construction is anticipated to be completed in FY 2021/2022. The Slurry Seal and Curb Ramp work will be funded with Gas Tax / HUTA, Gas Tax/SB-1, Measure A/ Western and Measure A/ Coachella Valley, City of Coachella, and City of Palm Springs funds.

PROJECT SPONSOR: Riverside County Transportation Department

PROJECT LOCATION: Various Locations

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: 4th & 5th Districts

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to provide slurry seal treatment to existing pavement surfaces on various roads located within Districts 4 and 5 of Riverside County.

Slurry seal treatments consist of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregate (very small crushed rock), water, and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface. The treatments are provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. Slurry seal treatments seal cracks, restore lost flexibility to the pavement surface, provide a new black pavement surface color, and help preserve the underlying pavement structure. The work also involves replacing non-compliant curb ramps, removing and replacing thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings/paint traffic stripes and other associated work as required.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: The proposed project does not require additional right-of-way. Temporary construction easements and utility relocations may be required. The project will extend the life of the pavement of the treated roads, which is a benefit to the traveling public. The project consists of maintenance and repair of an existing public road. There is no expansion of use of the road as a result of the project.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside and Coachella Valley MSHCP's. In accordance with Section 7 of both MSHCP's, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance and therefore is a covered activity.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities The project proposes to slurry seal various road locations within Districts 4 and 5. These minor improvements to the existing roadways are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the activity does not create additional automobile lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.






VICINITY MAP


