

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE TO PROTECT OUR SCHOOL CHILDREN, GRADES K-12, PUBLIC AND CHARTER SCHOOLS, FROM EXPERIMENTAL, COMPREHENSIVE SEXUALLY EXPLICIT EDUCATION IN OUR CLASSROOMS

Whereas Students are to be freed from oral, vaginal, anal, fisting, solo sex, "child-friendly" porn material in textbooks, along with Sexting Ideas, Drag Queen Story Hour and pornographically explicit sex education curriculum per the Comprehensive Sexual Education Act required by AB329 known as (The Healthy Youth Act);

Whereas Students are freed from mandated curriculum teaching them how to give, receive and negotiate (consent) to sexual activity, which violates the Minor penal code 288;

Whereas Students are freed from gender diversity/fluidity curriculum, which is not scientifically based;

Whereas Minor students (K-12) are not to be taught about medical issues such as puberty-blocking hormones and sexual reassignment surgery;
