BACKGROUND:

The Riverside County Transportation Department proposes to Vacate and Terminate Maintenance of portions of Leon Road that have been superseded by realignment and are no longer needed for circulation, in the French Valley area. Some portions of superseded Leon Road are still needed for access and circulation in the area and will not be vacated. Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) owns and operates a booster station along Leon Road and operates and maintains pipelines within Leon Road. The vacation preserves access to EMWD's facility and the Resolution to vacate and terminate maintenance will reserve an easement for any existing public utilities and public service facilities. EMWD has reviewed the vacation and has no objections. Once County maintenance is terminated weed abatement maintenance will be the responsibility of the abutting property owners. There are four (4) property owners abutting these portions of Leon Road. One of the abutting property owners is Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District (Valley-Wide). Valley-Wide has expressed concerns over the initial cost to improve this property to Valley-Wide standards and the ongoing cost of maintenance. The Transportation Department recognizes Valley-Wide's concerns and has agreed to pay the initial cost to improve the property to Valley-Wide standards in exchange for Valley-Wide maintaining the final product in perpetuity.

Pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Section 8320 et seq., the Board of Supervisors must hold a public hearing to determine whether the vacation of the subject portions of Leon Road are unnecessary for present or prospective use. Upon approval of the vacation and termination of maintenance by the Board of Supervisors the County and Valley-Wide will be entering into an agreement to memorialize the agreed upon terms. The other three (3) property owners abutting the portions of Leon Road proposed to be vacated were notified of this ongoing maintenance responsibility and no objections were made. The Transportation Department has removed the asphalt road surface over the portions proposed to be vacated at the request of the property owners. The Fire Department and Flood Control have reviewed this vacation and have no objections.

As determined in the attached Notice of Exemption, the vacation is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to Categorical Exemptions 15060(c) and 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines. The vacation will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the

categorical exemption and will not cause any direct or indirect physical environmental impacts.

County Counsel has approved resolution Number 2021-054 as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Vacation and Termination Maintenance of portions of Leon Road and Approval of a Maintenance Agreement will not impact residents or businesses.

Additional Fiscal Information

All fees are paid by Gas Tax/SB-1. There is no General Fund obligation.







AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND

VALLEY-WIDE RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY FOR MAINTENANCE OF VACATED LEON ROAD

This Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this <u>15</u>TH day of <u>20</u>, by and between the COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County") and VALLEY-WIDE RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, a political subdivision of the State of California ("District").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County proposes to Vacate and Terminate Maintenance of portions of Leon Road in the Winchester area; and

WHEREAS, the County desires that the property owners abutting the portions of Leon Road proposed to be Vacated take over weed abatement maintenance once County maintenance is terminated; and

WHEREAS, the District is the owner of certain real property known as Assessor's Parcel Number 480-220-039, more particularly described as follows:

Open Space Lot 91 and Lot "A" (Leon Road 50.00 foot half-width) of Tract No. 29675-1 on file in Book 336, Pages 94 through 99, inclusive, of maps, records of Recorder of Riverside County, California, lying within Section 32, Township 6 south, Range 2 West, San Bernardino Meridian, in the Unincorporated Territory of the County of Riverside, State of California.

WHEREAS, the District has agreed to not oppose the proposed Vacation and Termination of Maintenance and maintain in perpetuity that portion of Leon Road proposed to be vacated lying within said Lot "A" if the following conditions are performed and/or provided by the County:

- 1. Remove existing roadway asphalt, including base material.
- 2. Provide guardrail along the southerly boundary of the proposed vacation to prevent vehicle access.
- 3. Provide funding in the amount of \$24,914.22 for landscape improvements and vinyl fencing to bring this area up to District standards.

WHEREAS, the County has removed the existing asphalt and road base and installed the requested guardrail.

WHEREAS, the County desires to provide the requested funding to the District, and is hereby entering into this Agreement with the District, subject to the terms and conditions noted herein.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties to this Agreement do mutually agree as follows:

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF COUNTY

A. County shall pay to District the sum of \$24,914.22, which sum is mutually agreed upon as that necessary to improve this area to District standards and install vinyl fencing.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF DISTRICT

A. District shall provide project administration and construction management of the improvements and maintain the final product in perpetuity at no additional cost to County.

III. MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION

In the event that the Board of Supervisors of Riverside County, California, do not approve the proposed Vacation and Termination of Maintenance of Leon Road all obligations of the County and District herein shall cease. This Agreement may not be modified, terminated or rescinded, in whole or part, except by a written instrument duly executed and attested by the parties hereto or their successors or assigns.

IV. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California.



NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Name of Public Agency Approving Project: Riverside County Transportation Department, Survey Division, County of Riverside.

Name of Person or Agency Carrying Out Project: David L. McMillan, Riverside County Transportation Department, Survey Division, County of Riverside.

Exempt Status: California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. Not a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c).

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: Vacating a street has been determined to not be a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c). However, even if it was determined to be a project under CEQA for analysis purposes, vacating a street is exempt from the provisions of CEQA specifically by the State CEQA Guidelines as identified below. Vacating a street will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. Vacating a street will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Further, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would occur that may reasonably create an environmental impact. Vacating a street will not have an effect on the environment; thus, the County has deemed this does not meet the definition of a "project" under CEQA and no environmental impacts are anticipated to occur.

• Section 15061(b)(3) - General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. With certainty, there is no possibility that the proposed vacation and maintenance agreement may have a significant effect on the environment. Vacating a street and entering into an agreement for maintenance will not require any construction activities, change the use or intensity of the existing site to create a physical environmental impact, and would not lead to any direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical environmental impacts. Therefore, in no way would vacating a street have the potential to cause a significant environmental impact and the vacation is exempt from further CEQA analysis.

 Section 15060(c) – for purposes of analysis under CEQA, Vacating a street is not a "project" under CEQA pursuant to Section 15060(c). An action by a public agency is only a "project" subject to CEQA if the action might result in a physical change in the environment. Based upon a review of the whole action undertaken, supported, or authorized by the County, in no way will Vacating the street increase the use of the site, result in increased development or construction impacts, or lead to any direct, indirect, or cumulative physical environmental impacts.

Based upon the identified exemptions above, the County of Riverside hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.


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


