

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Restoration Agape - \$12,000** funding will be used to support a back to school backpack and school supply giveaway in the unincorporated areas of Mead Valley, Good Hope and Meadowbrook communities.
2. **Smiles for Seniors Foundation- \$1,000** to support their efforts of providing emergency assistance for food, housing, and utility payments as well as home and auto repair, and help pay for life saving prescriptions, and medical equipment for senior citizens in the 1st District.
3. **Red Zone, Inc. - \$10,000** funding will be used to support summer day camps for kids that are ages 6-14 for low socioeconomic areas that cannot afford summer camps. This is in partnership with the Val Verde Unified School District to serve 334 Children in the Mead Valley area.
4. **Friends of the Woodcrest Library - \$2,000** funding will be used to support community events including a Movie in the Park and the Cookies with Santa event held at the Woodcrest Library.
