BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Boy & Girls Club of Southwest County - \$2,500** funding will be used to support after school program at the Lakeland Village Clubhouse which serves residents of Lake Elsinore, Wildomar and Canyon Lake.
2. **The Concerned Family Ministry- \$1,500** funding will be used to support the daily feeding program for the homeless and low-income families in the Mead Valley area.
3. **Riverside University Health System Foundation - \$5,000** funding will be used to assist Riverside University Health System - Medical Center with specialized medical equipment.
4. **Perris Valley Thai Boxing & Martial Arts Corporation - \$1,500** funding will support the efforts to provide martial arts training and equipment to low income students in the Mead Valley community.
