2. Direct the Department of Information Technology to prepare and process Ordinance No. 965 in consultation with County Counsel.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Department of Information Technology (RCIT) requests the Board of Supervisors approval to initiate the development of Ordinance No. 965: An Ordinance of the County of Riverside Establishing Procedures and Limited Delegation of Authority to the Chief Information Officer or their designee to enter into License Agreements to provide rack and square footage space at the Riverside County Collaboration Center (RC3) and Information Technology Services that create revenue generating agreements. The Department will work with County Counsel to prepare the Ordinance. All provisions will be in accordance with local and State law.

RCIT desires to create a clear and concise ordinance and increase the efficiency of license agreements for information technology hardware and services that result in revenue generating agreements with external entities. RCIT would like to strengthen the Department's ability to manage the use of County maintained servers and County provided services by delegating the authority to execute the agreements to the Chief Information Officer up to \$50,000 per month.

RCIT maintains county owned facilities across Riverside County, such as Riverside County Collaboration Center (RC3), and provides a variety of services to non-county entities. These services include data storage, equipment housing, telephone services, and other information technology and communications services.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The creation of the ordinance is necessary to provide efficient services to third parties that generate revenue to the department and help offset costs that would normally be passed along to the County Departments.
