BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Social Work Action Group (SWAG) - \$5,000** funding will be used to support SWAG's efforts to create client stabilization for those who are at-risk of being homeless and the unsheltered chronically homeless.
- 2. Hospice of the Valley SC- \$2,500** funding will be used to support the Senior Assistance Programs that helps cover the direct cost of hospice care for senior citizens and the severely disabled.
- 3. Department of Animal Services - \$10,000** funding will be used to support mobile Spay & Neuter and Vaccine Clinics in the Good Hope, Mead Valley and Lakeland Village Communities.
- 4. Grove Community Church - \$4,000** funding will be used to support two Movies in the Park events in the Good Hope and Mead Valley communities.
