BACKGROUND:

Summary 5 1

In accordance with the provisions of Government Code Section 54985, this amendment revises the current property tax fees for services provided by the County Auditor-Controller.

Due to increases in labor costs, several of the property tax fixed charge related rates must be increased. Other fees related to property tax enrollment transaction fees will be reduced to reflect cost decreases caused by a reduction in overall costs associated with these services. Rates related to warrants, vouchers, garnishments, withholding orders, sheriff writs, and sales tax recovery will remain unchanged. The following is a summary of fee changes:

Ordinance 860.16 includes the rates the Auditor-Controller will be charging in Fiscal Year 2021/2022 for 16 services provided to county departments, taxing agencies outside the county

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(example cities), special districts (example water districts), employees and the general public (for garnishments and similar services) as follows:

The property tax general services fee was intended to recover costs associated with researching and providing significant amounts of information requested by consulting agencies. The rate has been eliminated due to the California Public Records Act.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The only fee charged to residence is the \$2.70 property tax timeshare fee which is added together with the Tax Collector and Assessor costs and recovered through the property tax bill.
