BACKGROUND:

Summary

In accordance with the California Vehicle Code, the Board of Supervisors has the authority to reduce the permissible weight of commercial vehicles on select county highways that are within residential areas if the use is determined to adversely affect safety. Ordinance No. 500 establishes and implements these permissible weight reductions and provides exemptions for certain commercial vehicles such as public transit buses, emergency response vehicles, etc. The proposed Ordinance amendment includes the addition of commercial vehicle permissible weight restrictions on certain county highways in accordance with California Vehicle Code (CVC), Sections 21101, 35712, and 35713. The restriction shall not be effective until signs are posted to give public notice of the weight restriction.

Based upon the results of an engineering study which included the circulation of commercial vehicles and existing field conditions in select residential areas, the Transportation Department has determined that the subject county highways within these residential areas are not suitable for use by commercial vehicles in excess of 14,000 pounds (7 tons), and therefore recommends the introduction of reduced permissible weight restrictions along the county highways summarized in the List of Proposed 7-Ton Commercial Vehicle Weight Restrictions. Additionally, the Ordinance amendment includes alternate route designations for affected commercial vehicles.

Environmental Findings

The County has determined that the project is exempt from CEQA because it meets the criteria set forth for the commonsense exemption. As detailed in Section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, the commonsense exemption states that CEQA only applies to projects which have the potential of causing a significant effect on the environment.

Reducing the weight of commercial vehicles in certain residential areas will reduce the impact on the environment and redirect the commercial vehicles to streets more suited for these vehicles. The adoption of the ordinance amendment can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, therefore the activity is not subject to CEQA.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Community concerns have been raised regarding an increase of commercial vehicle traffic within residential areas. Commercial vehicles tend to utilize county highways as cut-through routes in an attempt to avoid traffic congestion on regional highways. In regard to business impacts, commercial vehicles that have direct business along reduced permissible weight county highways are exempt from the restrictions. Alternate routes have been designated for non-exempt commercial vehicles.

Additional Fiscal Information

Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-67 requires that the Board of Supervisors consider the cost associated with preparing, processing, and implementing an ordinance amendment in deciding whether to adopt an order initiating the ordinance amendment. The cost to reduce the permissible weight of commercial vehicles is primarily for the installation of the required regulatory signs, which is estimated at about \$3,000 per amendment.




DISTRICT 2: 7-TON COMMERCIAL VEHICLE RESTRICTION VICINITY MAP ORDINANCE 500.3

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: District 2

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Ordinance No. 500.3 amends and replaces Ordinance No. 500.2 to reduce the permissible weight of certain vehicles on identified county highways. Ordinance No. 500.3 is to include the addition of subsection:

- f. Indiana Avenue between Neece Street and Grant Street, a total of approximately 0.45 miles in the Home Gardens area.
- g. Indiana Avenue between Grant Street and Hillview Drive (at the city of Riverside limits), a total of approximately 1.45 miles, in the Home Gardens area.
- h. Temescal Canyon Road between Tom Barnes Street and Minnesota Road, a total of approximately 0.67 miles, in the El Cerrito area.

Public transit buses, emergency response vehicles, and any other vehicles listed in section 4 of Ordinance No. 500.3 are exempt from this ordinance.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The addition of the above mentioned sections of Indiana Avenue and Temescal Canyon Road improves and regulates vehicle traffic on highways, roads and bridges in or near residential areas pursuant to provisions in the California Vehicle Code so as to improve quality of life and traffic safety. The restriction shall not be effective until signs are posted to give public notice of the weight restriction. Additionally, the Ordinance amendment includes alternate route designates for affected commercial vehicles.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 1506l(b)(3) - Common Sense Exemption - The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.
