BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated March 30, 2021 (Agenda Item 3.18), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Washington Street and Saddleback Road Pavement Widening and Traffic Signal Project in the Woodcrest Community of Riverside County within the Supervisorial District 1.

At this T-intersection, Washington Street is a two lane facility that travels in the north-south directions and Saddleback Road is also a two lane local road that travels in the east-west directions.

The project includes installing new traffic signal, safety lights, traffic signal cabinets, battery backup system, radar/video detection system, wireless radio communication system, new signage and striping, pavement widening at intersection, concrete retaining wall, erosion control, ADA compliant curb returns, curb and gutter, replacing existing traffic striping and traffic signs, and other associated work as directed by the Engineer.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The Addendum is included and attached herewith as Addendum No.1.

The Bid received from LC Paving has minor bid irregularities in the Subcontractors List. Construction items were specifically listed for each subcontract; however, a word description of the items of work was not provided. The proposal and contract identify the description of the specific items of work. The Transportation Department requests the Board of Supervisors waive these minor bid irregularities.

The contractor, LC Paving is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid. They have executed the Contract and have provided bonds and insurance documents that meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements. The work is anticipated to begin in the Summer of this current year (2021) and will take approximately two months to complete. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Contract is recommended to be awarded to LC Paving for the total amount of \$792,282. The construction contract is funded with Western County DIF Signal Mitigation Funds. The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project. The proposed budgets as shown on Attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Four bids were received on Wednesday April 21, 2021, ranging from \$792,282 to \$898,933. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by LC Paving in the amount of \$792,282 which is \$28,333 (-3.45%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The Contractor shall begin work within <u>fifteen (15)</u> calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.





These minor concrete structures shall be constructed in accordance with the County Road Improvement Standards and Specifications or as directed by the Engineer and in conformance with Section 51, 73 and 90 of Standard Specifications, except as modified.

The cementitious material content of concrete must be at least 590 pounds per cubic yard for:

Curb Ramps, Curb (Type D) and Driveway approach.

Refer to section 73-1.03 and 73-1.04 on page 48 and 49 of the Special Provisions. Delete Section 73-1.03 and 73-1.04 and replace entire section with the followings:

73-1.03 CONSTRUCTION

Add to Section 73-1.03B Subgrade Preparation:

Preparation of subgrade for the concrete structures shall be done in conformance with the requirements of Section 73-1.03B Subgrade Preparation of the Standard Specifications.

Excess material resulting from the excavation of the subgrade shall be disposed of as provided in Section 00-1.14, 'Disposal Of Excess Excavation Or Materials', of these Special Provisions.

Full compensation for the removal of existing minor concrete structures (Curb Ramps, Curb (Type D), and Driveway approach shall be considered as included in the contract bid prices for such minor concrete items of work.

The Contractor is responsible for meeting requirements of American with Disabilities Act (ADA), the current edition of the California Building Code, and the draft and final versions of the Accessibility Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities within the Public Right of Way as published by the United States Access Board.

Construction of Curb Ramps, Curb (Type D) and Driveway approach shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1) Removal and disposal of existing Curb Ramps, Curb (type D), Driveway Approach and existing soil and aggregate as required;
- 2) Establishing grades, and assuring that all grades are met;
- 3) Performing all grading and compaction including all required aggregate import, as directed by the Engineer and in accordance with County Standards;
- 4) Construction of new Curb Ramps, Curb (type D) and Driveway Approach;
