BACKGROUND:

Summary

Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution No. 2021-010 adopted May 11, 2021 (Agenda Item 3.35), the Board of Supervisors gave notice of a public hearing for June 29, 2021, to receive testimony regarding the Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 146 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 146 will fund the maintenance and servicing of streetlights within public rights-of-way located north of Grand Avenue in the Winchester area and includes one commercial parcel totalling 44.00 acres.

The annexation of territory to an existing assessment district formed under the Landscaping and Lighting Act is a change of organization that requires a public hearing as part of the annexation process. Streets & Highways Code §§ 22605(a), 22607, 22588; Government Code § 53753(d).

On May 12, 2021 a notice of the public hearing and information sheet, a mail-in assessment ballot, an impartial analysis, and a copy of Resolution No. 2021-010 was mailed to all property owners within Street Lighting Zone 146, proposed for annexation to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Pursuant to the notice, all assessment ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2021-010 in an appropriate newspaper at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of Resolution No. 2021-010 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two (2) other public locations within the County.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The new assessment is for the purpose of providing the maintenance and servicing of streetlights within public right-of-way.

Only the commercial property owners within the proposed boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 146, which are represented by Conditional Use Permit No. 03733, as described in the

attached Exhibit "A" (a two-page exhibit containing a description and diagram) are impacted by the cost of this annexation. The property owners within the proposed boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 146 have petitioned the County of Riverside to annex their property to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and understand that this annexation will result in an assessment on their property to fund the maintenance and servicing of the aforementioned improvements (streetlights).

SUPPLEMENTAL:

<u>Additional Fiscal Information</u>

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2021-22 for Street Lighting Zone 146 is \$220. This will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2021-22 within Street Lighting Zone 146 of \$5 per acre. The annual assessment may be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for electricity (CPI-U_Electricity), if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2021.
