BACKGROUND:

Summary

As a requirement of the Federal Qualified Health Center (FQHC) designation from the U. S. Department Health and Human Services, the County must have a governing board for the RUHS Community Health Centers. The Community Health Center Board (CHCB) was established by County Ordinance 751 in 1996. The CHCB presently has nine (9) to twenty-five (25) positions of which a majority must be users of services at the Community Health Centers. While the members must also be broadly representative of the characteristics of the population served by the FQHCs, certain positions are reserved for representatives of the County departments that work most directly with the CHCs to ensure integration of effort on behalf of the CHCs.

Christine Bromley and Steve Otta, applied to, had been reviewed by, and are recommended by the CHCB Board to this Board for reappointment on the CHCB as Patient Representatives.

An active, properly constituted FQHC Board is an important element of maintaining high quality care at the county's FQHC clinics.
