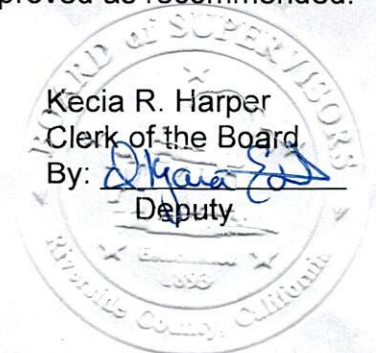

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to one (1) 2021 high school graduate who has served on the Second District Youth Advisory Council.

This amount was awarded to the incorrect university when this scholarship was originally awarded on June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021. There is no change to the financial amount being awarded, however the name of the university in which the student will be attending will be changed.

The scholarship award is designed to reward Second District Youth Advisory Council Members (YAC) to their hard work and to assist them with their education, which will improve our community.

Eligibility considerations are as follows:

- a. Graduating seniors attending community colleges, public colleges or universities, private universities or eligible trade schools;
- b. Proof of high school graduation;
- c. Participated in all mandatory YAC activities;
- d. Served on the council a minimum of one year (scholarships are \$250.00 for each year served on the council).
