BACKGROUND:

Summary

The 2020 General Election was held in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. The State of California implemented several Executive Orders and Legislative changes to address how the election would be conducted given the impacts of COVID-19.

On December 8, 2020, the Executive Office of the County of Riverside was directed by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors to conduct an After-Action Review of the 2020 General Election. The After-Action Review was subsequently expanded to include the 2021 March Special Election. Analyses of election activities were conducted to identify opportunities for process improvements and efficiencies, and return with a report and recommendations

On May 11, 2021, Item 3.38, the Executive Office recommended that the Registrar of Voters return to the Board of Supervisors on July 27th with a status update and cost analysis associated with implementing the recommendations included in the report. Since that time, the State has moved forward with setting a date of September 14, 2021 for the Governor's Recall Election, which has led to the Registrar of Voters quickly mobilizing all resources to prepare for that upcoming election. Given the current focus on preparing for the Recall Election, the Executive Office is recommending that the After Action Report be agendaized for the August 24, 2021 Board meeting to allow additional time needed for its completion.

This submittal requests an extension for the ROV to compile the requested information and present the findings on August 24, 2021.
