**BACKGROUND:**

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that more than 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges, economic development, and workforce representatives including labor organizations. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official, is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two-year terms.

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Mr. Greg Elgan, Business Representative for Operating Engineers Local 12, has represented the Union for the last seven years. He has participated as a delegate on Los Angeles County Labor Federation, Los Angeles and Orange County Building trades, San Bernardino/Riverside Building trades, Inland Empire Central Labor Council and the Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) for the past two years. Mr. Greg Elgan enjoys connecting job seekers into the workforce and educating others on how unions can improve the lives of working people through apprenticeship programs.

Mr. Elgan represents 18,000 members in Local 12 and brings their perspective to the board as well as what has been successful in not only initially getting people to work but continuing their employment for the long term. He is concerned with addressing pressing issues in the construction industry such as increasing the number of women in building trades, as it has been and still is, a predominately male industry. He possesses a strong understanding about the benefits of apprenticeship programs in providing education and hands on training to entry level workers. Mr. Elgan provides insight to the WDB on the Construction Industry as one of the identified in demand industries.

Mr. Greg Elgan has expressed interest in continuing to serve on the Workforce Development Board as a Labor Representative for All Districts. If reappointed, he will serve a two-year term commencing July 23, 2021 and expiring July 23, 2023.
