**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Project Touch- \$5,000 the funding will be utilized for housing and food for adults / children left homeless / unsheltered who reside in the Third District for one month.
2. Assistance League of Temecula Valley - \$3,000 the funding will be used for Operation School Bell which provides clothing and shoes for low -income children / youth residing in the Temecula / Murrieta areas.
3. MilVet- \$2,500 the funding will be utilized for shipping costs for the military care packages and special requests of service men and women who are deployed overseas.
4. Art Alliance of Idyllwild- \$1,000 the funding will be used to pay for shuttle service from art site locations for participants of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Art Walk event.
5. Hospice of the Valleys- \$2,500 the funding will go towards the Senior Assistance Program for residents in the Third District. The program offers durable medical equipment, medical supplies, medications, and wound care therapies.
