BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Project Touch- \$5,000 the funding will be utilized for housing and food for adults / children left homeless / unsheltered who reside in the Third District for one month.
- 2. Assistance League of Temecula Valley \$3,000 the funding will be used for Operation School Bell which provides clothing and shoes for low -income children / youth residing in the Temecula / Murrieta areas.
- 3. MilVet- \$2,500 the funding will be utilized for shipping costs for the military care packages and special requests of service men and women who are deployed overseas.
- 4. Art Alliance of Idyllwild- \$1,000 the funding will be used to pay for shuttle service from art site locations for participants of the 23rd Annual Art Walk event.
- 5. Hospice of the Valleys- \$2,500 the funding will go towards the Senior Assistance Program for residents in the Third District. The program offers durable medical equipment, medical supplies, medications, and wound care therapies.
