BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- Riverside County Works c/o Jamil Dada Character Excellence Youth Awards Ceremony- \$1,000 funds will be allocated to support Riverside County Workforce Investment Board's Scholarship Program at the Annual Character Counts Youth Awards Ceremony.
- 2. Riverside County Sheriff's Department- \$500 funds will be allocated to support two future community engagement events at Perret Park in Lakeland Village to introduce neighbors to their local sheriff deputies. This concept is similar to the National Night Out events where neighbors come out to meet their local law enforcement.
- 3. Rivers & Land Conservancy \$1,500 to support their efforts of the management of vegetation on the Orangecrest Preserve to ensure the sidewalks are clear for access by the community and the property is fire safe.
