

BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$1500 the funding will be used for the Chamber annual awards presentation that honors and supports exceptional businesses that demonstrate strong community involvement in the Temecula area.
2. Rotary Club of Temecula - \$3000 the funding will be utilized for food boxes for low-income seniors. In addition, the Rotary club provides supplemental food during the cold weather months for low-income families in the Southwest region.
3. SAFE Family Justice Centers - \$5000 the funding will be used to support annual fundraiser for SAFE Family Justice Centers that provides crisis intervention, safety planning and legal assistance for victims of crime.
4. Rancho Damacitas Children & Family Services - \$5000 for technology upgrades, computers and operating software for the homes and single moms who live at the empowerment village. The computers will help mothers reach their educational financial and personal goals of supporting their families.
