3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 20, 2021 at which time bids will be opened, and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to file the Notice of Exemption for the Cabazon Sidewalk Project in the Cabazon area with the County Clerk for posting within five working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of various segments of sidewalk along the east side of Broadway Street between Carmen Avenue and a point 325 feet south of Main Street; and along the south side of Carmen Avenue between Almond Street and just west of Cabazon Street in the Cabazon Area of Riverside County.

The purpose of this project is to provide a safer pedestrian route to travel to and from the Cabazon Elementary School.

Broadway Street and Carmen Avenue are two-lane roadways with existing dirt shoulders. Cabazon Elementary School is located on Carmen Avenue approximately 1/8 of a mile east of Broadway Street. The project will improve pedestrian safety by providing sidewalks and paved shoulder along the major routes to Cabazon Elementary School.

The scope of work includes constructing approximately 3,380 linear feet of concrete sidewalk including curb and gutter, driveway approaches, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps, fence installation, placing of roadside signs, traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, minor widening of the roadway to accommodate the new sidewalk and other associated work. The roadway widening will consist of removing portions of existing roadway and placing hot mix asphalt over aggregate base material.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The proposed project intends to construct sidewalk along Broadway Street and Carmen Avenue, as well as install additional minor safety improvements. The proposed activities are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the activities do not create additional traffic lanes and involve no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed improvements will improve pedestrian safety and provide an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant path. The new sidewalk will serve as a path to Cabazon Elementary School.

The work is scheduled to begin in January 2022 and will take approximately three months to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$607,767 and will be funded with Active Transportation Plan (ATP) - State funds for which the Transportation Department successfully competed.

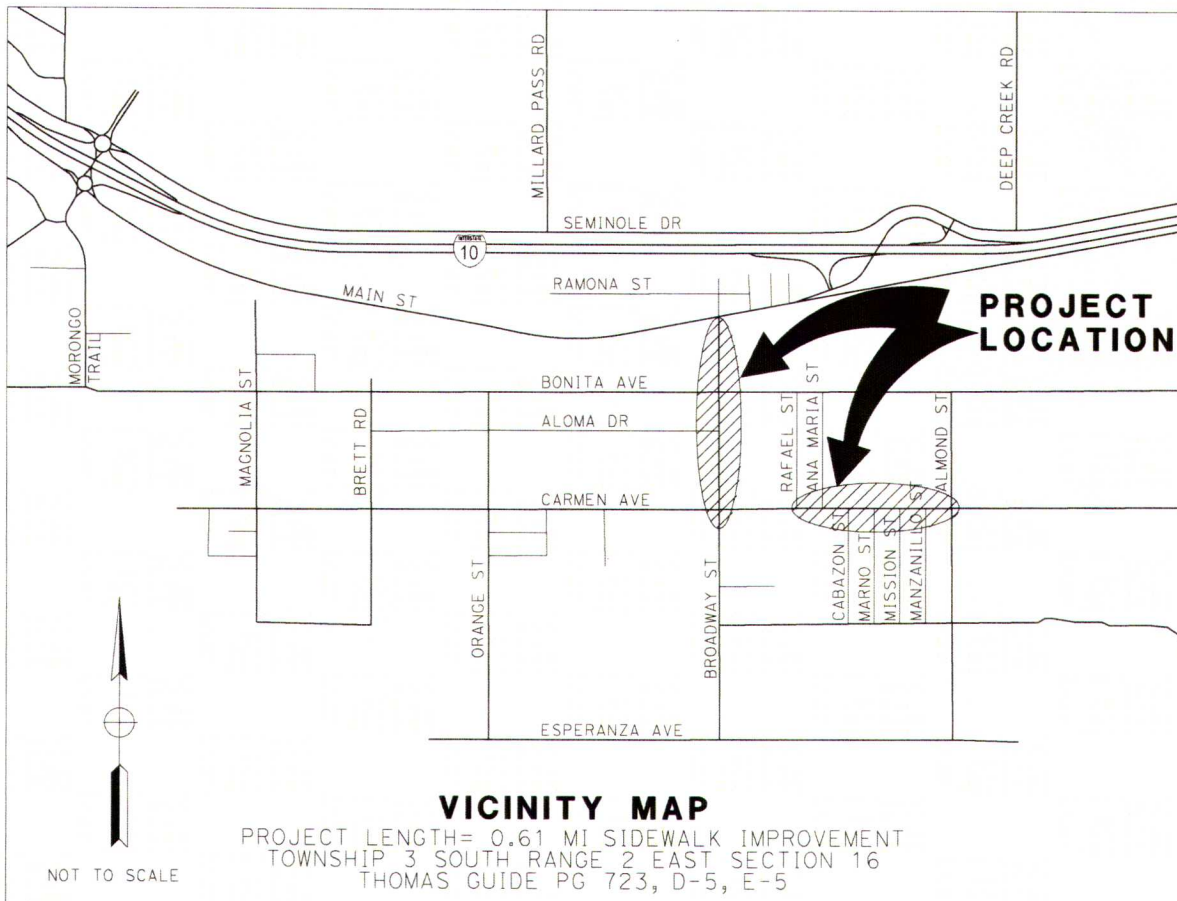
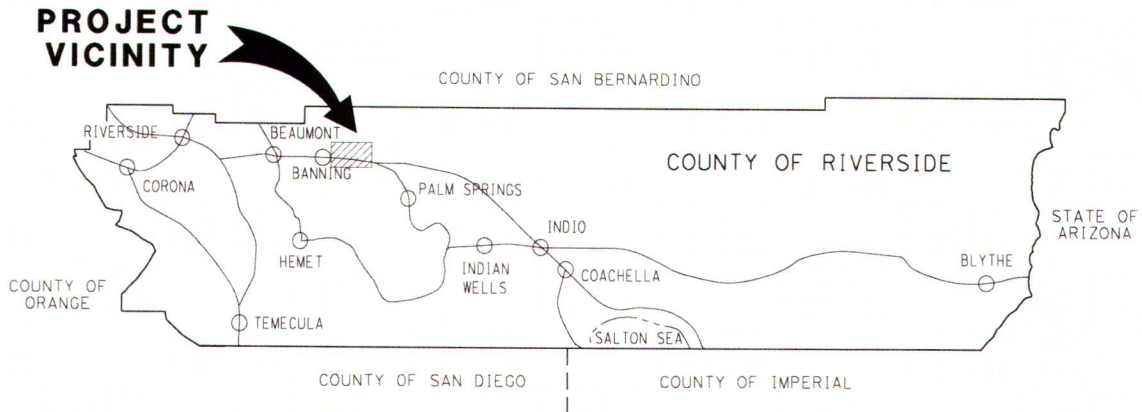

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside is proposing sidewalk improvements which includes construction/installation of approximately 3,000 linear feet of concrete sidewalk, curb & gutter, pavement widening improvements, ADA compliant curb ramps, driveway approaches, signs, markings, utility relocations and roadside object removal to improve the Broadway Street and Carmen Avenue routes to Cabazon Elementary School.

The proposed improvements extend the sidewalk from Cabazon Elementary to the north and to the east to improve student safety. Improvements are proposed along the east side of Broadway Street between Carmen Avenue and a point 400 feet south of Main Street; and along the south side of Carmen Avenue from 140' west of Cabazon Street to Almond Street in the Cabazon area of unincorporated Riverside County.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project requires minor acquisition of right of way. Temporary construction easements may be required. The project will benefit the community as a whole by improving safety and accessibility.

This project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7 of the Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside conservation areas. This project is not within a conservation area and is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Coachella Valley MSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:
