



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated July 27, 2021 (Agenda Item 3.42), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the 52nd Avenue Resurfacing and Calhoun Street Reconstruction Project, in the Community of Vista Santa Rosa and City of Coachella.

The 52nd Avenue Resurfacing Project will consist of two types of treatment.

52nd Avenue Limits	Treatment Type
County side (south half-width) from Monroe Street to 751-feet east of Jackson Street; and at Van Buren Street intersection	Remove existing asphalt concrete and underlying material and place back Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)
From 1077-feet west of Jackson Street to Van Buren Street	Grind asphalt concrete in place and overlay with HMA

The Calhoun Street Reconstruction project will consist of grinding the existing asphalt concrete in place and overlay with HMA between 54th Avenue and 790-feet north of 52nd Avenue.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of asphalt concrete driveway and dike, reconstruction of concrete driveways, placement of safety edge and shoulder backing to protect the outside edge of pavement, minor paved shoulder widening, utility adjustments, striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors, salvage/removal and installation of new signs, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to

improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). 52nd Avenue Resurfacing and Calhoun Street Reconstruction projects are two of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The contract includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid 1: 52nd Avenue Resurfacing and Calhoun Street Reconstruction
Alternative Bid 1: City of Coachella Portion

The City of Coachella has accepted the bid prices proposed by Granite Construction Company for alternate bid schedule 1. Therefore, the reimbursement agreement between the City of Coachella and County of Riverside is being submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval concurrent with the award of this project.

The contractor, Granite Construction Company, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Project No. D0-0065, C9-0012

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of 52nd Avenue and Calhoun Street, totaling approximately two miles, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in fall of 2021. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in FY 2021/22 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1, Measure A/Coachella Valley, and City of Coachella funds.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Seven bids were received on Wednesday August 18, 2021 ranging from \$1,790,818 to \$2,148,111. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$1,790,818 which is \$235,887 (11.65%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$1,790,818.

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and Granite Construction Company, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, 52nd Avenue Resurfacing, Monroe Street to Van Buren Street, Project No. D0-0065; and Calhoun Street Reconstruction, 54th Avenue to 0.12 Miles North of 52nd Avenue, Project No. C9-0012, Community of Vista Santa Rosa and City of Coachella, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders. (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of 2018 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (None), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.
