BACKGROUND:

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges, economic development, and workforce representatives including labor organizations. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official, is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two-year terms.

Ms. JoDee Slyter, Regional Director of ABOUT STUDENTS Consortium for Adult Education, Corona-Norco Unified School District, has been an adult educator for over 31 years in the Inland Empire as a teacher, program coordinator, and administrator. Throughout her career, she has

served on a variety of committees related to adult education including the California Adult Education Strategic Planning Committee, Comprehensive Adult Student Assessment System Program Evaluation Team, Association of California School Administrators Adult Education Council, the California Adult Education Administrators' Association Executive Board, the CALPRO Advisory Board and the WDB, among others.

Ms. Slyter is interested in serving a second term on the WDB to provide connections between businesses, community members and adult education. She is passionate about serving adult education students, with the focus on changing lives and addressing the key issue of bridging the gap in services between training and employment. Her participation on the WDB and its Western Regional Committee has helped her gain valuable experience, which can help her extend the value of the adult education contributions to the region. Ms. Slyter believes the potential for collaboration and growth opportunities for the residents in the community can significantly be impacted. Her years of experience in Adult Education and participation in the community make her an asset to the WDB.
