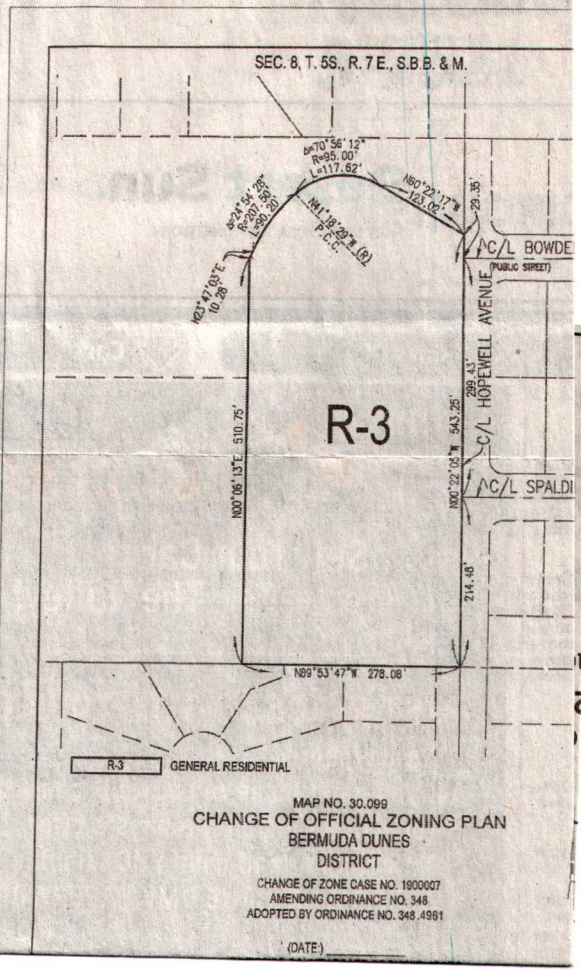

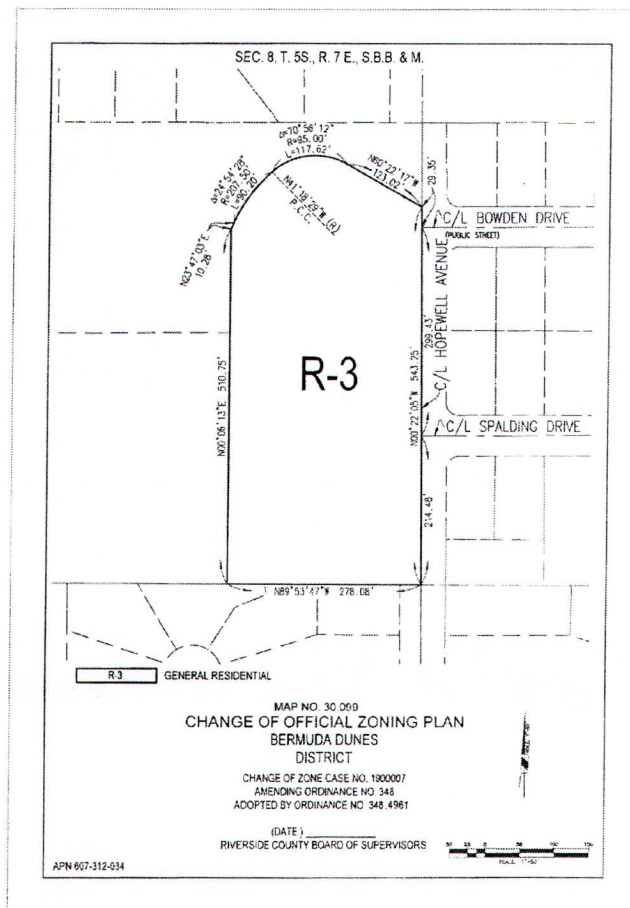

Section 1. Section 4.1 of Ordinance No. 348, and Bermuda Dunes District Zoning Plan Map No. 30, as amended, are further amended by placing in effect in the zone or zones as shown on the map entitled "Change of Official Zoning Plan, Lower Coachella Valley District, Map No. 30.099, Change of Zone Case No. 1900007," which map is made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 452,248
AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452 RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

- Section 1. Section 3.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Fifteen miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 2 to read as follows:
"2. On Laguna Avenue between Washington Street and Riverside Drive, a total distance of approximately 0.37 miles, in the Lake Elsinore area."
Section 2. Section 3.5 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Twenty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 3 to read as follows:
"3. On Briggs Road between Mapes Road and Gunther Road, a total distance of approximately 1.00 mile, in the Homeland area."
Section 3. Section 2.2 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 38, 39, 40 and 41 to read as follows:
"38. On El Mineral Road between Olive Street and Piedras Road, a total distance of approximately 1 mile, in the Perris area.
39. On El Nido Road between Piedras Road and end of paved road, a total distance of approximately 0.42 miles, in the Perris area.
40. On Golden Rod Road between Willow Avenue and the City of Temecula (180 feet south of Mirassou Circle), a total distance of approximately 0.19 miles, in the Temecula area.
41. On Piedras Road between Valle Pacifico Drive and Santa Rosa Mine Road, a total distance of approximately 1.42 miles, in the Perris area."
Section 4. Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 141, 142 and 143 to read as follows:
"141. On Carpinus Drive between Wood Road and Cajalco Road, a total distance of approximately 0.80 miles, in the Perris area.
142. On the southerly half of Main Street between Iowa Avenue and Mount Vernon Avenue, a total distance of approximately 1.50 miles, in the Highgrove area.
143. On Yates Road between Pourroy Road and Alegre Vista Road, a total distance of approximately 0.50 miles, in the Winchester area."
Section 5. Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 159, to read as follows:
"159. On 65th Avenue between Dale Kiler Road and Johnson Street, a total distance of approximately 0.50 miles, in the Mecca area."
Section 6. Section 2.5 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 188, 189 and 190 to read as follows:
"188. On Benton Road between SH-79/Winchester Road and Washington Street, a total distance of approximately 2.41 miles, in the Murrieta area.
189. On Chicago Avenue between Olive Avenue and Fairview Avenue/Cedar Avenue, a total distance of approximately 0.50 miles, in the Hemet area.

190. On Rancho California Road between Avenida Del Oro and the City of Temecula (4500 feet east of Via Santa Rosa), a total distance of approximately 1.25 miles, in the Temecula area."

Section 7. Section 2.7 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Fifty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 31 and 32 to read as follows:

"31. On Van Buren Boulevard between the Riverside city limits (530 feet west of Pine Court) and King Avenue, a total distance of approximately 2.46 miles, in the Woodcrest area.

32. On the southerly half of Van Buren Boulevard between Barton Street and Orange Terrace Parkway, and full width between Orange Terrace Parkway and I-215, a total distance of approximately 2.50 miles, in the Woodcrest area."

Section 8. Subsection 94 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance 452 adopted on June 02, 2009, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452,225, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 94 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on El Mineral Road between a point 265 feet west of Goldstrike Circle and the centerline of Piedras Road, a total distance of approximately 0.47 miles, in the Perris area.

Section 9. Subsection 96 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance 452 adopted on June 02, 2009, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452,225, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 96 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on Piedras Road between the centerline of Valle Pacifico Drive and a point 875 feet north of Copper Queen Lane, a total distance of approximately 1.0 mile, in the Perris area.

Section 10. Subsection 4 of Section 2.4 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452,214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 4 of Section 2.4 established a forty miles per hour speed limit on the southerly half of Main Street between Iowa Avenue and Mount Vernon Avenue, a total distance of approximately 1.5 miles, in the Highgrove area.

Section 11. Subsection 133 of Section 2.4 of Ordinance 452 adopted on September 11, 2012, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452,233, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 133 of Section 2.4 established a forty miles per hour speed limit on 65th Avenue between Home Avenue and Johnson Street, a total distance of approximately 0.4 miles, in the Mecca area.

Section 12. Subsection 2 of Section 2.7 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452,214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 2 of Section 2.7 established a fifty-five miles per hour speed limit on Van Buren Boulevard between a point 1,500 feet west of Barton Road to a point 338 feet east of the centerline of I-215, a total distance of approximately 2.61 miles, and between the city limits of Riverside and Washington Street, a total distance of approximately 2.7 miles, in the Woodcrest area.

Section 13. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
