BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- **1. California VFW Motorcycle \$1,500** funding will be used to support the Emergency Food Assistance Program that serves veterans, active military families, widows, and shut-in seniors within the First District.
- 2. Family Services Association \$1,000 funding will be used to support FSA's Hope for the Holidays program that provides support to foster youth during the holiday season. The funds will be designated for foster youth in the First District.
- 3. Riverside Medical Clinic Charitable Foundation- \$1,000 funding will be used to provide training to educators, law enforcement, youth leaders, and community representatives who are committed to ending bullying.
- **4.Riverside County Office of Education Foundation \$2,000** funding will be used to assist efforts to provide scholarships to disadvantaged high school students residing in the First District.
- 5. Community Outreach Ministry \$500 funds will be used to benefit their Annual Angel Tree Christmas Tree Project which will provide food and clothing to 200+ at-risk and/or needy children (ages 0-18) whose parents are incarcerated, as well as provide them with a holiday meal.
