BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing the construction of an approximately 1/4 mile segment of sidewalk improvements along the north side of Mayberry Avenue to fill in existing sidewalk gap between Peartree Lane and Casino Road in the Community of East Hemet.

The proposed improvements on Mayberry Avenue will include new curb, gutter, and sidewalk on the north side of the street between Peartree Lane and Casino Road and will extend the limits of the existing sidewalk. The sidewalk will provide a safer pedestrian path for travel to and from the Valle Vista Elementary School.

Additional improvements include construction of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant concrete access ramp at the intersection of Mayberry Avenue and Casino Road, concrete cross gutter, and residential concrete driveway approaches.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid: Mayberry Avenue Sidewalk Improvements

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The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Project No. D0-0101

Environmental Findings

The proposed project will construct sidewalk along the north side of Mayberry Avenue to fill in an existing sidewalk gap between Peartree Lane to Casino Road. This improvement is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed improvements will improve pedestrian and provide an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant path. The new sidewalk will serve as a path to and from Valle Vista Elementary School located easterly on Mayberry Avenue.

The work is scheduled to begin in January 2022 and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract estimate is approximately \$296,270. Construction is anticipated to be completed in FY 2021/2022. The Mayberry Avenue Sidewalk Project will be funded by SB 821 (Local Transportation Funds) and Gas Tax/HUTA funds.

The SB821 funds were secured through a Countywide process in which the Transportation Department successfully completed.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

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

PROJECT TITLE: Mayberry Avenue Sidewalk Project

PROJECT LOCATION: Community of East Hemet

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to construct sidewalk along the north side of Mayberry Avenue from Peartree Lane to Casino Road. This section of Mayberry Avenue does not have sidewalk on the north side except for a tiny amount east of Peartree Lane. The proposed project will construct new sidewalk starting from where the existing sidewalk ends, approximately 100 feet east of Peartree Lane, and continue for about 1,300 feet to Casino Road. The project will also construct a new curb ramp and return at the northwest corner of the intersection of Mayberry Avenue and Casino Road.

The proposed project will also include:

- Remove/replace any damaged curb/gutter and cross gutter
- Remove/replace driveways to be in compliance with ADA standards
- Utility adjustments
- Mailbox adjustment
- Vegetation/tree removal

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). Portions of the project are outside cell criteria areas. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside of cell criteria areas. This project will construct sidewalk within the right of way of an existing road. The project is considered to be an operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1st – September 1st), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The proposed project will construct sidewalk along the north side of Mayberry Avenue from Peartree Lane to Casino Road. These improvements are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.


