BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to reconstruct all legs of the existing roundabout located at the intersection of Rancho California Road and Anza Road, approximately 0.5 miles, in the Community of Rancho California in Riverside County.

Rancho California Road is classified as Mountain Arterial Road and Anza Road is classified as a Major Road in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Rancho California Road and Anza Road are two-lane roads and currently range from 26 to 46-feet wide as they approach the roundabout. Roadway reconstruction is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the reconstruction will consist of removing existing asphalt concrete and underlying material and place back new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) concrete pavement over aggregate base with geotextile placed between the pavement and aggregated base, and between the aggregate base and natural soil to provide subgrade enhancement thus preventing premature failure of pavement structure.

Additional improvements include paving a temporary hot mix asphalt roadway, placement of AC dike, reconstruction of curb and gutter and concrete curbs, pavement safety edge, placing of traffic striping, thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings, and other associated work.

The work will include a seven-day full closure of the intersection with 24 hours shifts to excavate, scarify, moisture condition, compact, and pave the road. Traffic will be detoured through Calle Contento, Pauba Road, De Portola Road and Glen Oak Road for commuters traveling to the west, east and south leg of the roundabout. A temporary roadway will be constructed on private property for commuters and residents needing to access the northerly leg of the roundabout. The remaining work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately three weeks to complete.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Rancho California Road and Anza

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Road Reconstruction Project is one of the County of Riverside's priority projects approved for use with the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB-1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Rancho California Road and Anza Road Reconstruction

Alternative Bid 1: Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) Manhole Adjustments

Alternative Bid 2: Frontier Manhole Adjustments

Alternative Bid 3: Metropolitan Water District (MWD) Manhole Adjustments

The adjustment of the facilities owned by EMWD, Frontier, and MWD, are included in the bid package as alternative bid schedules. If EMWD, Frontier, and MWD approve the award of their respective alternative bid schedules, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owners through reimbursement letter Agreements that will be executed by the Director of Transportation.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the sum of all bid schedules.

Environmental Findings

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Rancho California Road and Anza Road reconstruction does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadways and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for approximate 0.5 miles between all four legs of the Rancho California and Anza Road roundabout to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin spring 2022. The work will include a seven-day full closure of the intersection with 24 hours shifts to excavate, scarify, moisture condition, compact, and pave the road. Traffic will be detoured through Calle Contento, Pauba Road, De Portola Road and Glen Oak Road for commuters traveling to the west, east and south leg of the roundabout. A temporary roadway will be constructed on private property for commuters and residents wishing to access the northerly leg of the roundabout. The remaining work will be phased to keep the

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road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately three weeks to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,065,185. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 and developer contributions.

There are no General Funds used in this project.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface/reconstruct approximately 3,000 feet of the Roundabout at Rancho California Road and Anza Road. This includes resurfacing/reconstructing approximately 1,700 feet of Rancho California Road and 1,300 feet of Anza Road. Rancho California Road is classified as a Mountain Arterial road and is a 48 foot, two lane road. Anza Road is classified as Major Arterial road is also a 48 foot, two lane road. The proposed project will include:

- Removal of the existing pavement and base and placing Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), base, and subgrade enhancement fabric
- Construction of a 1600-feet long and 26-feet wide asphalt concrete temporary detour road
- Restoration of temporary detour road area to original condition after the asphalt concrete is removed
- Utility adjustments
- Striping of roadway

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed improvements will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements. A permit to enter and construct is required to construct a detour road.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The project area is outside of cell criteria areas. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside of cell criteria areas. This project will resurface an existing road within the existing roadway. The project is considered to be an operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1st - September 1st), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities - The proposed project will resurface and reconstruct approximately 3,000 feet of the Roundabout at Rancho California Road and Anza Road. The project will also construct an asphalt concrete temporary detour road that will be removed after project completion. The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.


