#### BACKGROUND:

#### Summary 5 1 1

The County of Riverside Transportation Department conducted Engineering and Traffic Surveys (E&TS) in accordance with the California Vehicle Code (CVC), Sections 627 and 40802, for various county-maintained roads in the Home Gardens, Mecca, Perris, and University City areas of Riverside County.

Based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads, the Transportation Department recommends the introduction of designated radar-enforceable speed limits along the road segments summarized in the List of Speed Zones, and has determined these speed limits to be appropriate to facilitate the safe and orderly movement of traffic. The Transportation Department intends to recommend adoption of these designated radar-enforceable speed limits at the January 11, 2022 Board of Supervisors meeting.

Transportation Department staff has notified the Riverside and Indio area offices of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) regarding the recommended speed zones.

#### Previous Agenda References

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The establishing and posting of appropriate speed limits promote safe and orderly movements of vehicular traffic and enable the CHP to use radar equipment to enforce the posted speed limits. Since the recommended speed limits were determined based on actual speed surveys, the majority of the motorists are already driving at or below the recommended speed limits. Posted speed limits also guide motorists to drive at a reasonable speed in unfamiliar locations.

### Additional Fiscal Information

The cost for establishing the recommended speed limits is primarily for the installation of speed limit signs, which is estimated at about \$ 3,500.

Subsection 43 of Section 2.5 established a forty-five miles per hour speed limit on Watkins Drive between the southerly boundary of the city limits of Riverside and the centerline of State Route 60 westbound off-ramp, a total distance of approximately 785 feet, in the University City area.

Section 12. Subsection 187 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance 452 is repealed in its entirety.

Section 13. Subsection 6 of Section 2.7 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 6 of Section 2.7 established a fifty-five miles per hour speed limit on Central Avenue between Sycamore Canyon Boulevard and the city limits of Riverside, a total distance of approximately 0.25 mile, in the University City area.
