4. Approve the project's proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated September 28, 2021 (Agenda Item 3.21), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Slurry Seal and Curb Ramp Accessibility Project for Fiscal Year 2021/22 at various locations in the communities of Lakeland Village, Mead Valley, Woodcrest, La Sierra, Lake Matthews and De Luz. The specific roads with their respective limits are listed in Attachment "1".

This project proposes to apply slurry seal and micro-surfacing treatments based on the condition of the existing pavement.

The slurry seal treatment is provided as a preventative maintenance measure to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. Slurry seal treatment seal small cracks, restore lost flexibility to the pavement surface and help preserve underlying pavement structure.

The micro-surfacing treatment is similar to a slurry seal except it uses polymer modified and fast setting asphalt emulsion allowing thicker layers to be placed. The thick layer application is used to fill in ruts commonly found on roads with light to moderate truck traffic.

This project also proposes to reconstruct or upgrade thirty-four (34) existing concrete curb ramps at various locations within District 1 as part of the Transportation Department goal to provide safe and usable pedestrian facilities for all pedestrians and to comply with the Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. As part of the ADA requirement, curb ramps must be upgraded when adjoining roads are altered through resurfacing or placement of a thick layer of seal coat. The specific curb ramp locations are listed in Attachment "2".

The proposed curb ramp accessibility work will consist of modifying or removing existing concrete curb ramps and reconstructing new ADA compliant concrete curb ramps. Certain curb ramps will be upgraded by installing yellow detectable warning devices (series of small bumps or truncated domes) and making repairs to street landing slopes to meet ADA compliance.

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Detectable warning devices are used to alert pedestrians who are blind or visually impaired that there is vehicle traffic nearby.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$2,405,843:

Base Bid Schedule 1:	Slurry Seal Project
Alternative Bid Schedule 1:	Curb Ramp Accessibility Project
Alternative Bid Schedule 1.A:	Curb Ramps at Signalized Intersections
Alternative Bid Schedule 2:	Slurry Seal Project, City of Lake Elsinore Portion
Alternative Bid Schedule 3:	Slurry Seal Project, City of Wildomar Portion

The Cities of Lake Elsinore and Wildomar have accepted the bid prices proposed by American Asphalt South, Inc. for alternative bid schedules 2 and 3, respectively. Therefore, the reimbursement agreements between the Cities and County of Riverside are being submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval concurrent with the award of this project.

The contractor, American Asphalt South, Inc., is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds that meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Slurry Seal treatment will extend the life of the pavement thereby reducing the need for more extensive types of resurfacing that can be up to ten times more costly.

The reconstruction of curb ramps is expected to improve the access and safety of disabled persons using the pedestrian facilities along the roadways. In addition, bringing the curb ramps up to current accessibility standards contributes toward fulfilling the County Transportation Department's goals as stated in its ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan as required by Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

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The work is expected to begin in January of 2022 and will take approximately two months to complete. The slurry work will be halted temporarily between January and March 2022 due to anticipated rain and cold temperatures and will resume in April 2022.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Contract is recommended to be awarded to American Asphalt South, Inc. for the total amount of \$2,405,843. The slurry seal and curb ramps accessibility Contract is funded with Measure A/ Western, City of Lake Elsinore, and City of Wildomar funds.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs. There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Five bids were received on Wednesday October 27, 2021, ranging from \$2,405,843 to \$2,855,120.

The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by American Asphalt South, Inc. in the amount of \$2,405,843 which is \$210,144 (9.6%) above the Engineer's Estimate of \$2,195,699.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to American Asphalt South, Inc. in the amount of \$2,405,843.

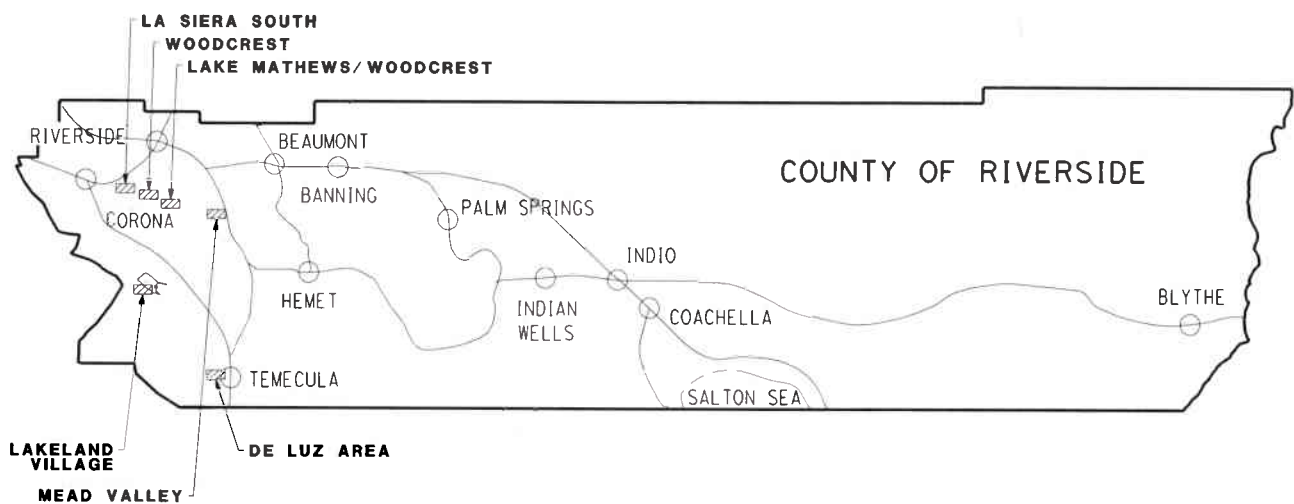

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and American Asphalt South, Inc., hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, Slurry Seal and Curb Ramp Accessibility Project, For Fiscal Year 2021 – 2022, District 1, Project No. D2-0006, D2-0011, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of 2018 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (Two), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents.
