### BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. My Learning Studio \$1,000 funds will support free and fee-reduced tutoring for children through the Fill the Gap tutoring program. My Learning Studio is dedicated to serving low-income, fostered, and adopted at-risk youth.
- 2. Smiles for Seniors Foundation \$1,500 funding will allow the Smiles for Seniors Foundation to help support low-income seniors by assisting with food, housing, utility payments, prescriptions, and medical equipment.
- 3. Menifee Rotary \$1,500 funds will support fundraising efforts for programs and projects throughout the City of Menifee that target seniors and youth. The Menifee Rotary promotes education, ethical conduct, career mentoring and humanitarian service.
- 4. California Family Life Center \$2,500 funding will be utilized to provide food, clothing, utilities and employment and education support services to families in the Third District.
- 5. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee \$2,500 funds will be used towards the Annual Concert for Heroes held every July 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Riverside National Cemetery. The concert is open to the public and is free to attend.
